

# House of Lords Petitioning Privacy Notice

HS2 Ltd. will process the personal data that you provide to us in accordance with our Privacy Notice (<https://www.hs2.org.uk/privacy-notice/>).

This Notice aims to provide details regarding specific purposes for which we process your personal data.

## 1. Why Are We Processing Your Personal Data?

In order to fulfill our obligations in relation to the High Speed Rail (West Midlands - Crewe) Bill, HS2 Ltd. is required to consider, and respond to, petitions submitted against the proposals. Specifically, we need to process your personal data in order to:

- communicate with you regarding your petition, including sending you a response to your petition.
- accurately identify on a mapping system the location of all the petitioners affected property in relation to the proposed line of route proposals to better inform our processes and decision making.
- fairly and accurately process any claims that you may choose to make under the various compensation schemes available (see <https://www.gov.uk/claim-compensation-if-affected-by-hs2/overview>).
- assist in the preparation of exhibits and information packs in support of the Select Committee hearings.

## 2. Is There a Requirement to Supply HS2 the Personal Data?

There is not a requirement to provide this data to HS2 Ltd.

## 3. Will the Personal Data Processing Be Subject to Any Form of Automated Decision Making?

No. Automated decision making is not used.

#### **4. Who Do We Disclose Your Personal Data To?**

Your personal data may be shared with:

- our partners
- stakeholders
- other government departments

Personal information will only be shared where it is necessary in order to fulfil the purposes outlined above or where there is a legal requirement to do so.

However, please be aware that, in accordance with the petitioning guidance produced by the Private Bill Office in the House of Lords, your petition, including your personal data, will be published.

#### **5. Where Do We Process Your Personal Data?**

Your personal data will be processed within the UK or the EEA. Where transfer outside of the EEA becomes necessary in order to fulfil the purposes, we will inform you, either directly, by updating this Notice, or both.

#### **6. How Long Will We Be Holding Your Personal Data For?**

Your personal data will be held until Parliamentary consideration of the Bills for HS2 is complete, currently expected to be 2023.

#### **7. The Source Of The Personal Data, And If Applicable, Whether It Came From Publicly Accessible Sources.**

Your information has been supplied to us by the Private Bill Office in the House of Lords.

## **8. Where HS2 Intends To Further Process The Personal Data For A Purpose / Reason Other Than That For Which The Personal Data Were Collected.**

Your information will only be processed for the purposes detailed in this Notice. Where further processing becomes necessary, we will inform you, either directly, via an update to this Notice, or both.

## **9. Your Rights:**

You are afforded a number of rights regarding the way in which HS2 process data about you, which are as follows:

- the right to access a copy of your personal data held by, or on behalf, of HS2.
- the right to request HS2 to rectify, erase, or restrict the personal data we hold about you,
- the right to object to HS2 processing your personal data,
- the right to withdraw your consent allowing HS2 to processing your data at any time.
- the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office.
