This map shows the location of the construction sites that we will be establishing and explains the different activities that will be happening there. A timeline is shown overleaf.





Construction activities timeline





Once we have secured possession of a site for construction, we will erect temporary board fencing around the area to ensure the safety of the site. Additional activities taking place as part of these works are: vegetation clearance and security and site preparation.



After HS2 has possession of a site, ground investigations and building condition and ecology surveys are undertaken ahead of demolition of any existing structures.

Site clearance and demolition

Site clearance and demolition of existing structures will begin to prepare the sites for HS2 activities.



Activities could include preparing the ground for construction and delivering the physical works required to build the new railway and station.



Interim taxi rank

The taxi rank is operational until 2021. The interim taxi rank will remain operational in the western half of Euston Square Gardens until 2021 at which point it is relocated elsewhere (e.g. relocated to Eversholt Street).

From 2021, the western half of Euston Square Gardens becomes a construction site as HS2 builds a new pedestrian underpass link to London Underground Euston Square tube station. The new link will open in 2026.



Railway systems

This will see: fit-out of electrical and mechanical systems; and testing trains and the track by running trains along the line of route before it becomes fully operational.



Archaeological investigations

Ground investigations and initial site clearance have been carried out. The main burial removals are currently taking place.



Construction support site

If needed, this site will support grouting activities related to the London Underground station works.



Utility diversions

To prepare the land for construction, we will remove or relocate power cables and services to facilitate building work. Utility works will be happening from 2018 onwards.



Engagement event

Information events will be held in your area throughout the year. Your local Engagement team will hold monthly drop-in sessions.

1 National Temperance Hospital and St James's Gardens site including demolitions

Works taking place in this area include demolition of the hospital and clearance of the site. Archaeological investigations and exhumation works are taking place. Once cleared, this will be used as a construction compound to support station construction works.

West of Euston Station

The buildings are being demolished to make space for the new station. Once cleared, this will be used as a construction compound to support station construction works.

3 Melton Street site

Once these buildings are demolished, the site will be used as a construction compound to support station construction works.

4 Euston Square Gardens

The interim taxi rank will remain operational in the western half of Euston Square Gardens until 2021 at which point it will be relocated elsewhere (e.g. relocated to Eversholt Street).

From 2021, the western half of Euston Square Gardens becomes a construction site as HS2 builds a new pedestrian underpass link to LU Euston Square tube station. The new link will open in 2026.

Utility works are ongoing throughout 2019–2020. These works will consist of removing or relocating services to facilitate building works. These works will also include the Thames Water water main diversion works, which are shown on the map.

Other utility works are being confirmed and are not yet shown on this version of the map. The map shows the current approved lorry routes. Future routes will be confirmed in due course.

5 Future construction sites
Euston Station forecourt

The buildings at the front of the station forecourt will be demolished to become a construction compound to support the station construction works.

6 Future construction site

This is a possible future construction site for a grouting shaft at Lancing Street. This site may be needed for a grouting shaft, depending on the development of the detailed design.

7 Future oversite development
Lendlease is developing plans for the station
area. It will be consulting on its plans in 2019.
