Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. The Government's current strategy sets out that construction activity should continue as long as work can comply with Government and Public Health England guidance. We understand that some of the local community have concerns about the continuation of construction activity along the route of the Chiltern Tunnel and Colne Valley during the COVID-19 outbreak. We will be keeping our local websites, up to date with information on our works, and the measures we have in place to maintain the safety of the community and our workforce.

What work will be taking place?

We are installing signs to direct our Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) to our vent shaft site off Whielden Lane in Amersham. To install these safely we will need to put in temporary traffic lights for two days between 8am and 6pm at the junction of A355 Gore Hill and A413 London Road West on Wednesday 10 and Thursday 11 February 2021.

Why do we need these signs?

As the main construction works to build the vent shaft for the Chiltern Tunnel at Amersham, we need to ensure our HGVs use the correct and agreed routes to get to the site. These signs are being installed at key junctions on the main road network around Amersham.
