High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Working under Covid 19.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing Covid 19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it applies with the guidelines. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. We have postponed all face to face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities such as letters and phone calls as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites. What are we doing?

SGN will be undertaking a pipeline diversion off Oxford Road (A418). Due to the early works undertaken in September 2020, it **will not be necessary** to utilise any temporary traffic signals within or adjacent to the carriageway (Oxford Road). SGN will start their main utility diversion works in March 2021. This will allow for the future construction of HS2.

How will this affect you?

A limited number of vehicles will be exiting and joining Oxford Road from the site access road (there will be no right turning of vehicles). Therefore, local traffic may have to slow down to permit the construction vehicles to exit the carriageway safely.
