High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.

Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. We have postponed all face-to-face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities, such as letters and phone calls, as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites. What are we doing?

As part of HS2's preparation works, a small temporary construction compound is required to be set up in Grove Farm alongside the Wendover A413 bypass.

The location is near to the junction of the A413 and Small Dean Lane. This compound will be used as a base for our works in the local area and will remain in place to support the initial main construction work.

Duration of works

These works will take place early February 2021 and will be complete by mid February 2021

Normal working hours Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm. Our contractors will be on site for start-up and shut down for one hour either side of these times

What to expect

Additional vehicles on the A413 including construction traffic and delivery vehicles

The presence of work operatives within and around the works location

Temporary lighting around the compound

What we will do

Manage the works so as to minimise disturbance

Manage any environmental impacts,

What is a construction compound?

This temporary construction compound will act as a local hub for the construction works in the area and provide;

- Office and welfare facilities
- Storage of materials and equipment to be distributed to sites in the area. No overnight accommodation will be permitted
- Car parking for workers

All the buildings on the site will be temporary and the site will have safety fencing and 24 hour security during the duration of the works.

The works will consist of the following:

- Using the existing A413 bypass lay-by site entrance will enable vehicles to enter and leave the site, maintaining road surface cleanliness on the A413
- Temporary fencing and low-level lighting around the compound

When will this work take place?

Compound works will begin early late January 2021 and will be complete by mid-February 2022.

How will this affect me?

All vehicles making deliveries to the site for the compound works will use the designated routes along the A413. The contractor will be closely monitoring the roads around the site and will take actions to keep your roads clean.
