Installation of electricity cables

Dear Customer,

We run the electricity network delivering power to your area and we are due to start work soon on a project to upgrade equipment to ensure reliable power supplies for local homes and businesses. Our work should not impact your electricity supply.

The work, in partnership with our contractor Modus Utilities, is needed to provide a new electricity connection for the HS2 Project.

Work is due to start on 15th January 2021 with planned working hours of Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm. There may be sections where we need to work at the weekend, but we are looking to minimise those shifts.

We expect to complete all the works by the end of June 2021. During this period, works will be carried out within the carriageway/footway of Albert Road, Canterbury Terrace, Canterbury Road, Chichester Road, Cambridge Road, Princess Road, Rudolph Road, Kilburn Park Road & Carlton Vale.

The works will consist of excavation of a cable trench in sections as the works progress along the route. Each section will be fenced off and acoustic barriers will be installed to limit noise impacts. We will provide clear signage to direct pedestrians around the work sites. The works will require suspension of parking bays and bus stop suspensions for some of the sections along the route. We will provide updates at hs2in-kilburn-northolt.co.uk.

We will continue to follow government and Public Health England advice to keep our employees, contractors and customers safe and our work will be carried out in line with the latest COVID-19 health and safety guidance. Thank you for maintaining social distance while our teams work in your community
