## Location of our Westgate site



**Skanska Costain STRABAG Joint Venture (SCSJV)** is our Main Works Civils Contractor between Euston and West Ruislip (see map to left).

They are responsible for building the HS2 ventilation shafts, headhouses, tunnels and other structures in London. SCSJV are not building Euston or Old Oak Common stations.

### Where is our Westgate site?

The Westgate site will be located in the industrial area near the A40 and River Brent. From December 2020, we will be starting work at this site to get ready for construction of a ventilation shaft and headhouse.



## Works planned at Westgate site in 2020/2021

From December 2020, we'll start works to set up the Westgate site for future construction of a ventilation shaft and headhouse.

Works planned during winter 2020/2021 are shown in the table to the right. The dates for these works may change.

When we have set up our site, you will be able to see our site offices and welfare facilities from your workplace. You may also notice vehicles entering and exiting our site






- Approximate location of our site offices and welfare facilities

# Future works to build a ventilation shaft and headhouse

Ventilation shafts and head houses are an essential part of building a new railway.


These provide access to the tunnels for maintenance and emergency services, ventilation and electrical power supply.

## Materials proposed for the headhouse

We're planning to use similar materials at all head houses between Euston and West Ruislip, but the combination of materials will vary depending on the local area.

Our current scheme design for the Westgate head house includes a combination of timber, metal, concrete and brickwork.








## Our future landscaping plans

When we have built the ventilation shaft and headhouse, we plan to landscape the site. We are planning to use a combination of materials including:

- Blocks/slab paving
- Woodland habitat planting
- Scrub habitat planting
- Grassland habitat planting
- Green roof on the headhouse

We'll keep our neighbours updated about our future landscaping design plans.
