Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within these guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review

What are we doing?

We are continuing the preparatory works in your area. The works for the preparation and installation of render and decorative paint finish, on the west elevation of Canterbury House will be starting from mid-March 2021, for a duration of six weeks - **please note that our programme of works is indicative. It requires dry weather and temperatures of five degrees or higher. We will provide you with updates at <https://hs2inkilburnandnortholt.commonplace.is/>**

We will carry out the work using hand tools and mobile elevating work platforms to provide temporary access to required areas. We do not expect these works to be noisy, however we will use acoustic barriers to keep noise to a minimum.

Parking spaces at Canterbury House will not be affected and access to the car park will be maintained at all times. These works will be supervised to help ensure the safety of residents and site personnel moving through the area.
