High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Temporary traffic management on Welsh Road

As part of the Fosse Way highway works, LM are installing utilities off Welsh Road close to the Fosse Way. To enable these works to be carried out safely we will need to install some temporary traffic management as follows:

22 March – 23 March– 'Stop and Go' to facilitate unloading and access to work area.

27 March – 28 March – Full road closure for utility crossings 29 March – 04 April – temporary traffic lights with a lane closure for utility connection works

Access will still be maintained for households and businesses along the road. All works are subject to consent, site and weather conditions. Dates may also be subject to change.
