Update of utility works on Gower Street, Gower Place and Euston Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's strategy makes it clear construction activity can continue, as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites remain under constant review. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.HS2inCamden.co.uk.

The programme of utility works to the west side of Euston Station includes the laying of electrical power connection ducts and BT telecommunication ducts via North Gower Street across Euston Road, Gower Street and Gower Place finishing at Gordon Street. It also includes laying new Verizon ducts starting at Euston Road, through Gower Place, Endsleigh Gardens and finishing at Upper Woburn Place.

At each location of works parking and loading bays will be suspended. Pedestrian access will be maintained. The initial digging of the road will be the noisiest activity, although this will be intermittent and not continuous. We will put up screening clad with acoustic panels to reduce noise.

We might use a vacuum excavator, which is a safer and faster way of working, as it sucks up material to expose buried utility services without risk of damaging the cables or pipework below. This is a noisier method, and we erect acoustic barriers around the machine, however a lot of the noise would be sent vertically, when the machine is running. We apologise in advance for inconvenience this might cause.

Utility supplies and other services will not be affected by these works.

Euston Road

We are continuing to lay communication and electrical ducts across Euston Road from North Gower Street to Gower Street in phases until end May. We are in final phase until 18 April before we start works in the junction with Gower Street.

From 19th April 2021 until end May, the west bound slip road from Kings Cross towards University College Hospital will be closed. Access will be maintained only for emergency services and patient transport vehicles via Gower Place. Traffic diversion signs will be in place for all other vehicles.

To speed up the completion date, weekend works will be in operation.

Summary of works

Working hours:

Mon to Fri 8am-6pm; Sat 8am-1pm

What to expect

- Gower Place to remain open for Emergency services.
- Traffic management around work sites and in surrounding roads.
- Loading and parking bay suspensions.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

Euston Road:

- Works across Euston Road from North Gower Street to Gower Street until end May.
- Euston Road Westbound slip to be closed with diversion route.

Notification

Gower Place and Gordon Street

Gower Place remains closed between Gower Court and Gordon Street and we are carrying out works in the west side of Gordon Street.

We maintain vehicular access for the Wellcome Trust, UCL building, emergency vehicles and patient transport to University College Hospital.

The footpath remains open.

We intend to complete the work and reopen Gower Place and Gordon Street junction by 18 April prior the closure of Gower Street.

Gower Street closure

From 19 April to the end of May works will continue on Gower Street at the junction with Euston Road. The Euston Road slip road will be closed.

We have worked with Transport for London and Camden Council to plan the closure and traffic diversion route.

Traffic diversion route to follow Euston Road – Upper Woburn Place – Woburn Place – Bloomsbury Place – Bloomsbury Square – Great Russell Street – Bloomsbury Street – Gower Street – Grafton Way

Access for emergency services and patient transport vehicles will be maintained as following:

- Access only for emergency services via Euston Road eastbound slip road
 Gower Street
- Access from east via Endsleigh Gardens Gower Place
- Access from west via Tottenham Court Road Beaumont Place or University Street
- Non-emergency vehicles to follow diversion signs: 'For patient access to hospital please follow'. Please follow Euston Road – Upper Woburn Place - Great Russel Street – Bloomsbury Street – Grafton Way.

During this closure, all buses will be diverted westbound towards the Euston underpass and the bus stops (W and Y) outside of the hospital will be temporarily suspended. The nearest bus stop P (Euston Square Station) will be temporarily relocated further east on Euston Road; for southbound please use bus stop N (Caper Street) in Tottenham Court Road.

A specific notice will be displayed at each bus stop regarding each bus diversion route

Bus diversion route Euston Road – Great Portland Street – Osnaburgh Terrace – Euston Road and returning towards Kings Cross.

Gower Place:

- Works to complete by 18 April
- Access via Gower Street

Gower Street from 19 April to end May:

- Vehicular access only for emergency services
- Patient Ambulance access/Drop Off
- No Entry signs in place at the junction with Gower Street


Gordon Street


