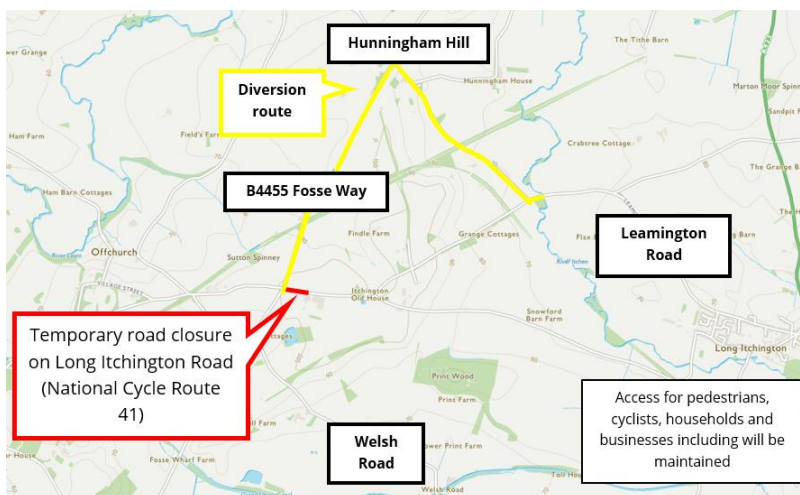

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Diverting Long Itchington Road during working hours

A section of Long Itchington Road East (also known as National Cycle Route 41) is due to be temporarily closed and diverted during LM's working hours from **Wednesday 17 March to Wednesday 24 March**. Closures are needed to safely build a new access point and new road crossings, and finish utility work.

Access will be maintained for pedestrians, cyclists, households and businesses along the route, and a signed diversion will be in place. If your property frontage is within the closure points, we will work with you to manage access into and out of your property. You may sometimes experience a short delay while we move machinery or create a safe path within the closed area during our working hours.

HS2 during COVID-19

We are continually reviewing work on our sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The timeframes in this notice may be subject to change due to consents, site and weather conditions.

Duration of work

Daytime closures, only during our working hours, from 17–24 March.

Our working hours

Monday to Friday between 8am and 5pm. We might be on site for up to one hour before or after these times, to set up or pack up.

What to expect

Potential traffic delays.
Some noise from machinery.

What we will do

Ensure the **one.network** website is updated with traffic management details.

Ensure on-the-road signs show the diversion route.
