# **Notice of utility surveys** near Blenheim Crescent

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within these guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review.

## What we are doing

From 6 to 9 April 2021, we will be carrying out sewer system investigations along the rail tracks south of Blenheim Crescent, in the area shown on the map overleaf. This will help to inform our design decisions in the area.

We will investigate the condition of the sewer system using a CCTV camera mounted on a small robot. Should we find a blockage, we may need to flush the drainage system using a high-pressure water jet in order to carry out the investigation.

To ensure the safety of operatives and rail users, these works will take place at night during a rail possession.

# How the surveys might affect you

You may see people operating the along railway tracks. Your utility services will not be affected.

From 6 to 9 April 2021 between 6pm and 8am

We may be on site for an hour before the start and/or end of each shift

Operatives and surveying equipment (including a CCTV camera) will be present, as well as a water tanker should we need to clear a blockage

#### What we will do

Ensure lights face work area only

We do not expect any noise during these works


