Over the coming months, we'll be carrying out some work to prepare the way for High Speed 2 (HS2). To keep our staff safe, we may need to work at times that cause the least disruption to train services and passengers which can include weeknights and weekends. We're sorry if our work disturbs you. We'll make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do, use silenced generators and have continuous noise monitoring to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits. Our staff will also be regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.

The maps and tables contained within this letter will help you to identify the work planned near to your property.

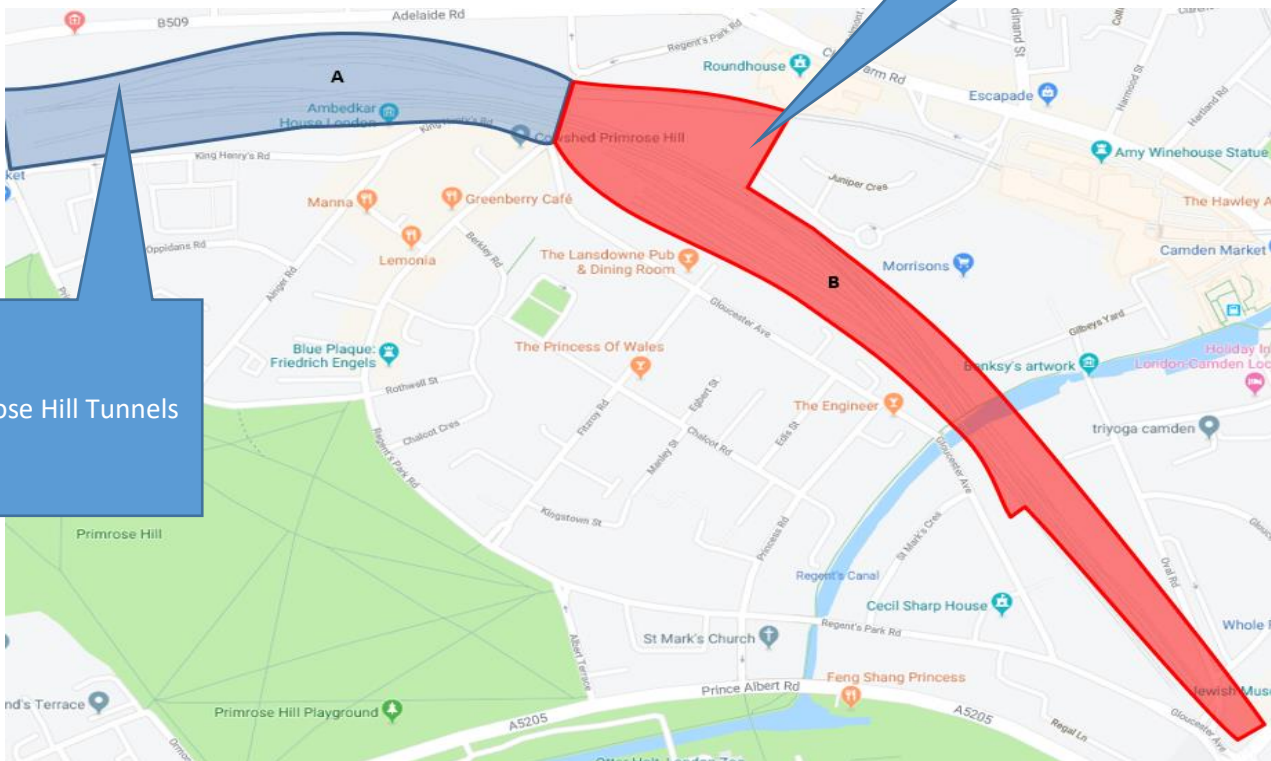

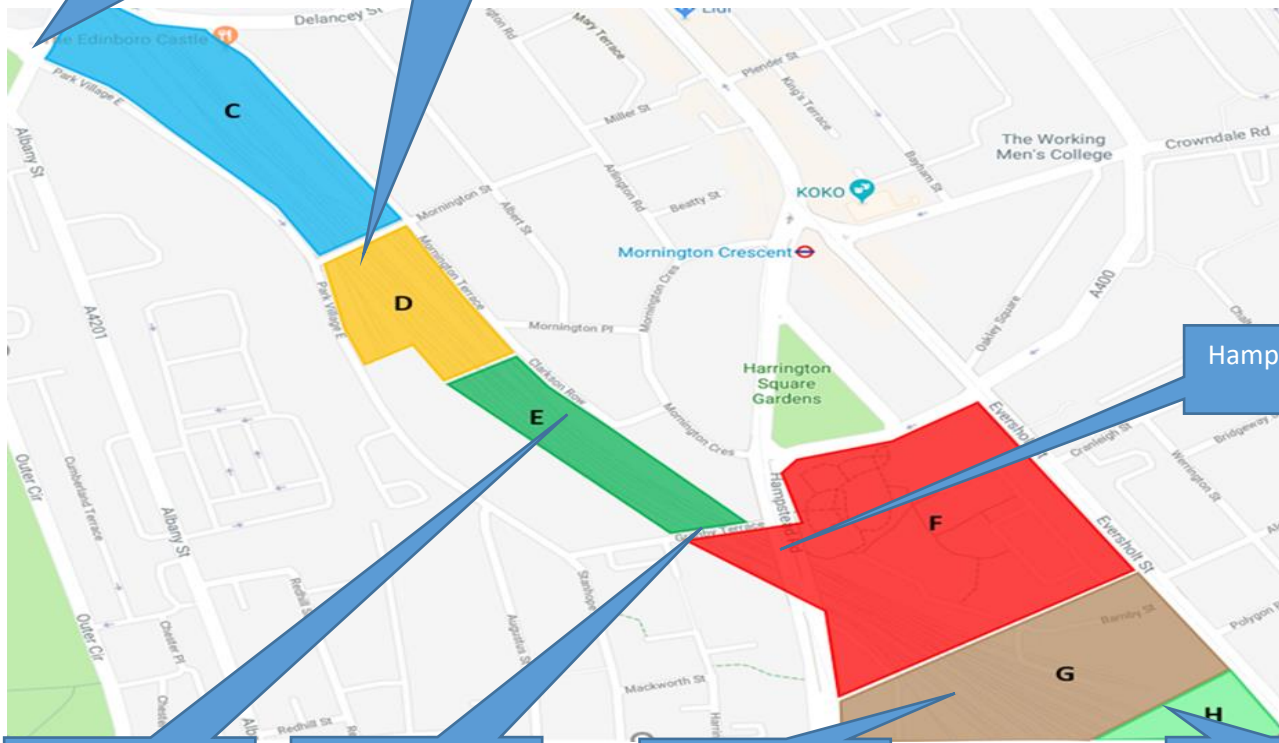

Other work in your area:

Skanska Costain STRABAG (SCS) is building the railway structures for the section of HS2 between Parkway and Hampstead Road bridge. From December to February, SCS will be carrying out piling and excavation works within their worksite beside the Network Rail tracks. SCS will also continue their works to the bridges and retaining wall within the cutting, carrying out surveys and monitoring and installing ground anchors. SCS will provide local residents with advance notice of construction impacts before they begin works.
