







Noisy works in front of Cartmel and Coniston

Date: 29 November 2023 to April 2024

Working hours: Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm

Noisy works: From 9.30am

We are currently constructing a large retaining wall in front of Regent's Park estate. This wall, which extends from Granby Terrace to Hampstead Road, will form the side of the new HS2 railway cutting.

From late November 2023 to summer 2024, we will work at the bottom of the trench we have been excavating to build large concrete slabs. We will use a high powered water blaster to roughen the top of the concrete piles before we build the concrete slabs.

We will work in sections, working from Coniston towards Cartmel. We expect it will take about four months to complete all the piles.

Please note, this work can be noisy. We will cover our working area with acoustic tents and monitor the noise closely to ensure we are working within the approved limit.
