Notice of overnight utility surveys on Park Royal Road and Cullen Way

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within these guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review

Surveys in your area

We will be carrying out further drainage surveys in your area during April. We previously notified you about drainage surveys planned on Park Royal Road opposite Acton cemetery overnight on 29 March 2021. Unfortunately, these works were unable to take place as planned and have now been rescheduled to take place overnight on 21 April 2021. These surveys will help us understand the condition of the drainage system in the area and how best to protect it during construction of the railway.

Overnight drainage surveys on 21 April 2021

These works will be carried out in three locations:

- Park Royal Road (Opposite Acton Cemetery) 9pm to 6am
- Park Royal Road (Outside Park Royal Works) 9pm to 6am
- Cullen Way (Adjacent Park Royal Works) 9pm to 6am

Temporary changes on Park Royal Road and Cullen Way

In order to carry out these works safely, temporary lane closures and parking bay suspensions will be in place overnight on Park Royal Road with temporary closures and diversions on Cullen Way and surrounding roads. The location of these surveys and temporary changes are shown on the maps on the following pages.

Access will be maintained to all properties at all times.

Working hours

Overnight from 9pm to 6am

We may be on site for an hour before the start and /or end of each shift

Temporary lane closures, diversion routes with traffic management to keep staff safe and traffic flowing

A water tanker will be on site should we need to clear any blockages

You may notice additional noise should we need to jet the drainage system

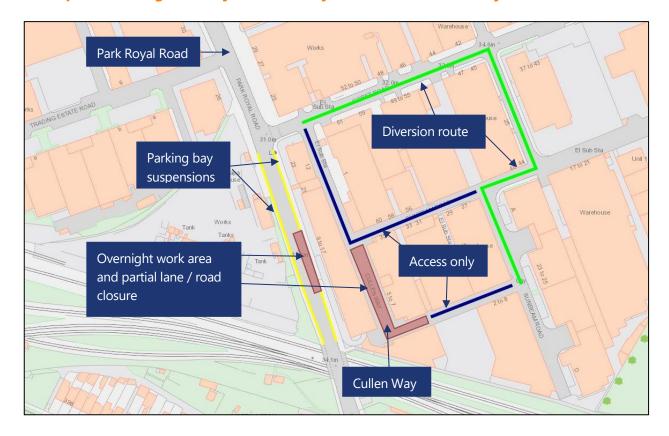
