Work on behalf of HS2 Ltd – local electricity diversions complete

I wanted to let you know that we've completed our overhead electricity line diversion scheme in Staffordshire for HS2 Ltd in preparation for the build and operation of the new railway. The completion of this project marks the conclusion of National Grid's Phase 1 and Phase 2a electricity transmission diversion work for HS2 Ltd in this area.

Our contractor, Balfour Beatty, has raised the height of four pylons that the new HS2 railway will pass under. This includes two pylons between Handsacre and Hanch, two between Bromley Hayes and Kings Bromley and the replacement of the overhead lines along the route.

We've completed this work within a year and on time and have now lifted our footpath closures on Longdon 35 and Kings Bromley footpaths 7, 8, 11 and 12.

Thank you for your assistance and patience while we've carried out these works.
