Update of works at Atlas Road roundabout in Victoria Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within these guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review.

What are we doing?

Atlas Road roundabout and Victoria Road – we have moved onto the next phase of works and have progressed from Atlas Road into Victoria Road to lay the electrical power ducts for the required power connections.

We are sorry these works have been delayed and apologise for extending the four-way traffic management on the Atlas Road roundabout to **17 May 2021**.

We have uncovered a complex arrangement of cables in the ground and are using a vacuum excavator and hand digging methods to avoid damage to the utility services.

We need to maintain the current traffic management to maintain safety for road users, pedestrians, and our workforce.

Once we are suitably clear of the Atlas Road roundabout, we will remove the current four-way traffic management and install two-way traffic management on Victoria Road.

What to expect

Four-way and two-way traffic light management measures will be in place

Bus stops and cycle lane suspensions

Intermittent noise whilst the road surface is broken

The sites will be secured with barriers and noise reduction panels

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works
