We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within these guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review.

Extended working hours within the Victoria Road Crossover Box site

Works are ongoing at the Victoria Road Crossover Box site to build a ventilation shaft and prepare for future construction of the crossover box below ground. As mentioned in our previous notification to you in April 2021, some of these works will need to take place during extended working hours.

From early June 2021 until Spring 2022, we will be extending our working hours on the Victoria Road Crossover Box site. This means that we will initially be able to undertake work on site from **7am on Monday** to 1pm on Saturday, which will then we extended to 6pm Saturdays from early August 2021

Outside of our core working hours of 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8pm to 1pm on Saturdays, we will only carry out works agreed with Ealing Council and will adhere to the agreed working hours, noise and vibration limits. We will do all we can to minimise disruption to our neighbours. We will minimise lighting as much as possible while safely carrying out the works. We will continue to monitor noise, dust and vibration throughout our works to ensure that we have adequate measures in place to minimise disruption to you. We appreciate your continued patience while we build HS2.

Construction of Diaphragm wall


We are continuing works to prepare the ground for future excavation of the Victoria Road Crossover Box. Part of these preparatory works include the construction of a diaphragm wall (D-Wall). A D-wall is a concrete wall built in the ground to give support and allow for excavation of underground structures.

The diaphragm wall will be constructed by excavating narrow panels in the ground. These panels which will be supported initially by an engineered fluid (bentonite) until the fluid is replaced by permanent reinforced concrete. This procedure will be continued until the footprint of the wall is complete.

Work is due to commence on 7 June 2021 and will last approximately seven months. Excavation works on the D-Wall will commence during our core hours of 8am to 6pm Mondays to Fridays and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. Concrete pouring and curing will take place during our core and extended hours. A map showing the location of these works may be found on page 3.

Sprayed concrete lining (SCL) of ventilation shaft

We began excavation of the ventilation shaft in early 2021 and are now 10 metres deep. The image below shows a cut section of the ventilation shaft and the steps of how it will be constructed.



- **1.** Excavate and install two rings of precast concrete segments
- 2. Install a concrete collar at ground level around the first two rings
- **3.** Continue to excavate in one metre layers and install precast concrete rings
- **4.** Once we hit London clay continue excavations in layers applying sprayed concrete lining


We have now completed the majority of the precast concrete rings and are reaching the stage where we begin our sprayed concrete lining (SCL) section. The SCL works are due to commence from mid-June 2021 until September 2021. The SCL and shaft excavation works will take place throughout the day and night. This must be carried out as a continuous process to avoid collapses and ensure the safety of the workforce in the ventilation shaft. A map showing the location of these works may be found on page 3.
