High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.

Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. We have postponed all face-to-face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities, such as letters and phone calls, as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites. What we will be doing?

Following on from the bat surveys information in our last notification we will now be continuing our established programme of bat mitigation. To enable this to happen safely at some locations we will need to have a full road closure or alternatively in other locations a lane closure (traffic lights). All works will take place between 09.30am until 3.30pm. This is to allow ecologists to safely observe and where necessary climb roadside trees to check for habitat. Subject to the outcome of these surveys tree limbs / trees may be felled at this time. The programme, location and type of traffic management required is detailed below:

Full Road Closures 09.30am until 3.30pm

- Boddington Road 19, 20 and 21 July 2021
- Culworth Road 22 and 23 July 2021
- Claydon Road 23 to 27 August 2021

The roads will be open as usual outside of these hours.

What will we be doing continued?

Rolling Lane Closure with traffic lights 09.30am until 3.30pm

- Welsh Road & A361 Byfield Road 12 to 14 July 2021
- Claydon Road 23 to 27 August 2021
- Leisure Drive 26 July to 13 August 2021

The roads will be open as usual outside of these hours.

Details of the road or lane closures and diversion routes can be found on the maps enclosed.

To notify road users of the upcoming road closure, verge advance warning signs will be erected.

The diversion signage will be in place and operated during the working hours described, however road closed signs will be removed when non-working hours resume. These signs will be mounted on standard A frames and secured with ballasted sandbags.

How may this affect you?

We will be working hard to ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these and all our future works. You may notice a little extra traffic on the road immediately around the sites with workers and delivery vehicles moving to and from the site. There may be some noise from the machinery. All machinery will be restricted to running between the hours of 8am to 6pm.

For this stage of works we will not be closing any Public Rights of Way.


