# Trial hole works at Victoria Road & Shaftesbury Gardens

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review.

# Trial hole work – Victoria Road junction with Shaftesbury Gardens, 14 June to 18 June 2021

Prior to the commencement of the next phases of laying the tunnel boring machine cable ducts along Victoria Road, trial hole works need to be completed in Victoria Road at the junction of Shaftesbury Gardens.

The work will last five days; an excavator will be used initially to dig the trial hole, with the remainder of the hole dug by hand so that the existing utility services, cables and pipes can be exposed without damage (this can be a lengthy process due to their depth), the services will then be surveyed. Once completed the hole will be back filled, reinstated and the road will be reopened. This piece of work needs to take place to prevent delays in the future planned works along Victoria Road.

During the work two-way traffic lights will be in place to maintain traffic flow along Victoria Road. Access into Shaftesbury Gardens will be maintained via a diversion through Midland Terrace. Once this is complete the works along Victoria Road will continue. We will update you about further phases in due course.



Where possible and in consultation with TfL, we will relocate suspended bus stops to a new temporary location close by, however it is not always possible due to the distance between stops and other highway restrictions.
