High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Bridge surveys in July 2021

During July, our surveying team will be visiting railway bridges on Greenford Road, Horsenden Road and Alperton Lane to carry out surveys overnight. We'll also visit the West Gate underbridge at Hanger Lane roundabout. The surveys will help to inform our design decisions in the area.

We will take pictures and investigate the condition of the bridges using a mobile tower and ladders. The surveys should not cause any disruption.

Due to the location of the surveys, temporary traffic management will be in place to ensure the activity can be carried out safely.

Survey dates

The surveys are planned on the following dates:

- Lyon Way – 5 July to 7 July
- Alperton Lane – 6 and 7 July
- Greenford Road – 7 and 8 July
- Horsenden Road South – 8 and 9 July
- West Gate underbridge, Hanger Lane roundabout – 9 and 10 July

Overnight survey on Greenford Road – 7 and 8 July

On 7 and 8 July our surveying team will be visiting the railway bridge on Greenford Road between Rockware Avenue and Uneeda Drive / Bennetts Avenue. A lane closure and temporary traffic lights will be in place overnight.



Overnight survey on Horsenden Road South – 8 and 9 July

On 8 and 9 July our surveying team will be visiting the railway bridge on Horsenden Lane South near Selbourne Gardens. A lane closure with temporary traffic lights and bus stop suspension will be in place overnight.

On 9 and 10 July our surveying team will be visiting the railway bridge between West Gate and A40 Western Avenue. Pedestrians and cyclists will still be able to use the underbridge while the surveys are being carried out.
