

Notice of vegetation work – A418, Aylesbury

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.

Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. We have postponed all face-to-face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities, such as letters and phone calls, as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites. What will we be doing?

As previously advised we continue to undertake ecology surveys and vegetation / tree clearance along the A418, Oxford Road corridor. This includes works to the north in the area of the former Aylesbury Golf Course and the opposite side of the A418. As some of our works to the south of the A418 need to be carried out on or adjacent to the highway we will at times need to put in place two-way temporary traffic management on the A418. This will include a temporary footpath closure to carry out these works safely. Please refer to the map overleaf that shows the working areas.

Duration of works

Works will begin on 29 July 2021 and last for up to four weeks

Working hours between 9:30 am and 3:30pm. Monday to Friday.

What to expect

Some noise from our equipment around our worksite

Two way temporary traffic management

Possible delays to your journey time

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints, taking appropriate action

Work hard to ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum.

Take care to respect your community.

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How will this affect you?

For the safety of road users and personnel involved with the works, we will need to implement a lane closure and use temporary traffic signals to manage A418 traffic. The lane closure will be managed by two way traffic lights which will be required for up to four weeks. To minimise the disruption to the community and motorists we will be carrying out this work between the hours of 9:30am and 3:30pm. Outside of these hours the road will be open as normal.

Roadside advance warning messaging signs will be in place prior and during the works to alert road users.

To allow us to work on vegetation close to the highway, and to protect all road users, from possible falling debris, we will at times need to implement a temporary hold on all road users. This hold will last no longer than two minutes and will occur no more than once every hour. Access along the A418 footpath will at times also be restricted. Pedestrians will be held for no more than 15 minutes, with access provided once the area has been made safe.

The vegetation clearance will generate low levels of noise. We will continue to work hard to ensure that any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these works.

The works are scheduled to take place Monday to Friday. Although the works are detailed to take up to 4 weeks duration we plan on reducing this period of disruption to the minimum.

Why are the works taking place now?

These works need to take place ahead of the main construction activity starting later this year which includes the establishment of a new compound and construction of the internal site access road.

What consents do we have to undertake this work?

There have been extensive ecological and tree surveys undertaken for the areas identified for clearance. Before any vegetation and trees are cleared the area will be thoroughly inspected by qualified ecologists. Any protected species found to be present will be recorded and no vegetation will be cleared within the buffer areas until the species have left the site, this includes nesting birds.
