Notice of weekend road closure on short sections of the B4438 and A452 in August

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are being carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons, known as LM. In your area, we are working near the A452, A45 and M42, which surround the site of the future HS2 Interchange Station.

We're improving the local road network

We are remodelling and improving sections of the existing road network in the area and creating new routes on HS2 land. These road improvements will ensure that when the future station is operational, the local road network is fit for purpose. Upon completion, a new T-junction will replace Northway Island. A new 'longabout' is already in operation outside the Holiday Inn Express NEC, on the way to the National Exhibition Centre (NEC).

We started the creation of the new T-junction in April 2021. To enable us to continue to connect parts of the existing road network, to the new routes we create, a series of weekend road closures will be installed in 2021 near Northway Island.

We'll be installing a weekend road closure in August

To carry out this programme safely, we will install a temporary, weekend road closure on short sections of the B4438 (northbound) and A452 (both directions), near Northway Island, from 8pm on Friday 13 August through to 5am on Monday 16 August (see map on page 2).

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times to set up and close down the site. A signed diversion route will be in place for road users during the weekend road closure. If work progresses faster than expected, we will reopen the B4438 and A452 earlier if possible.

Throughout the closure, there will be temporary changes to access to and from Birmingham Business Park off Northway Island (see map on page 3).

Duration of works

From 8pm on Friday 13 August through to 5am on Monday 16 August.

What to expect

Temporary, weekend road closure on short sections of the B4438 and A452 near Northway Island.

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times to set up and close down the site.

Throughout the closure, there will be temporary changes to access to and from Birmingham Business Park off Northway Island

What we will do

Install a signed diversion route for road users during the closure.

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

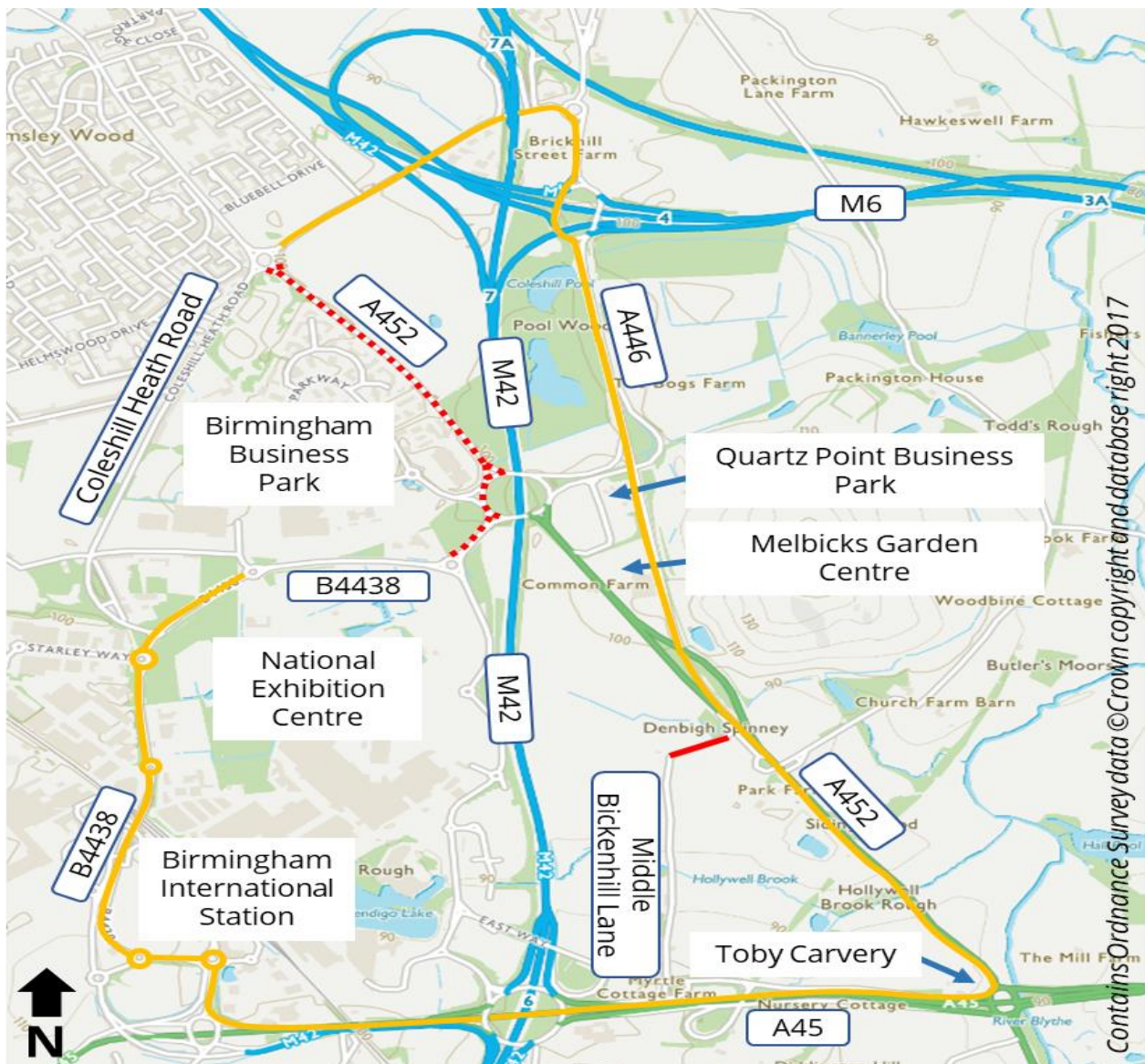

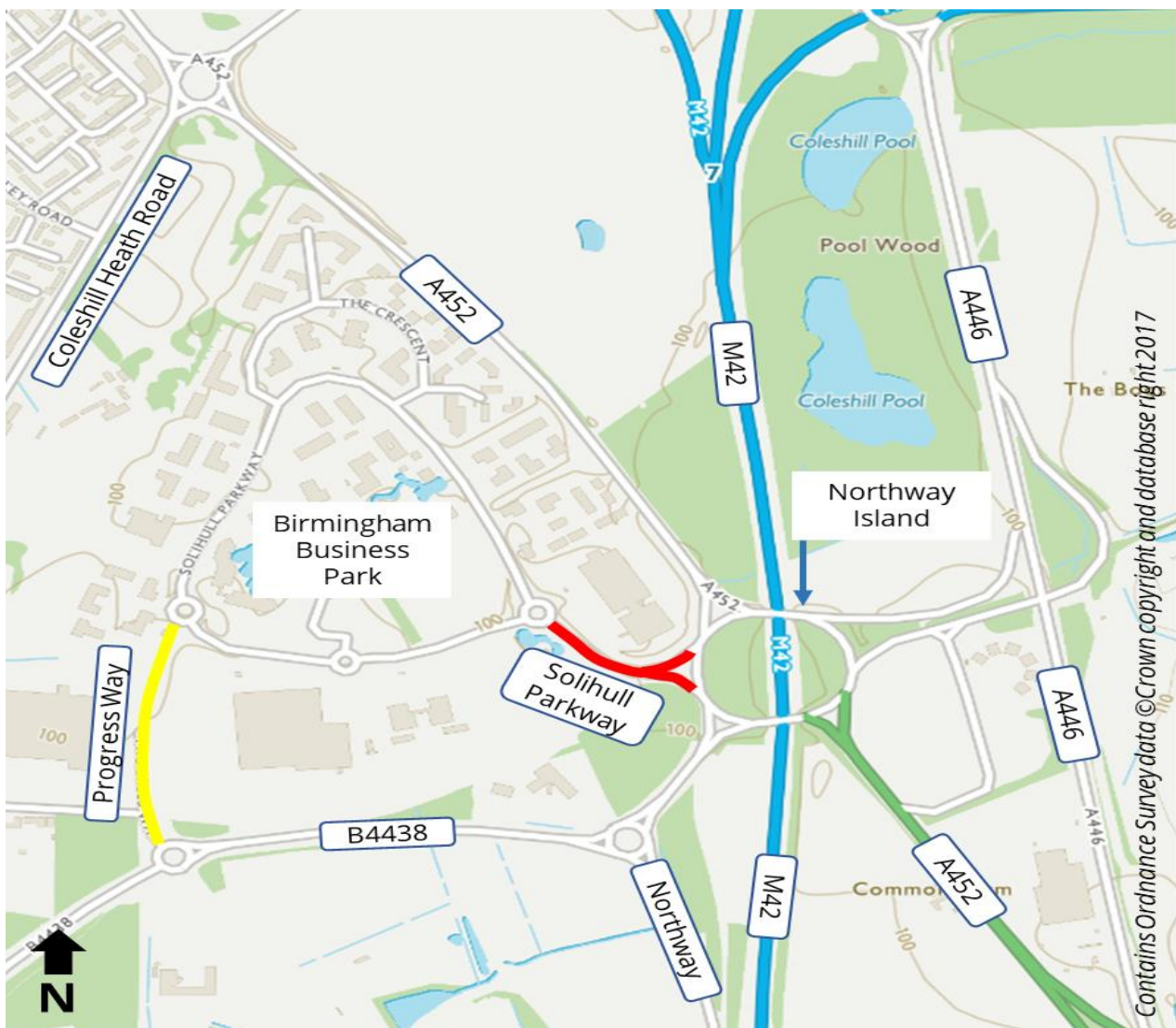

Temporary changes to access to and from Birmingham Business Park in August

The map below outlines the location of a temporary closure of Birmingham Business Park's entrance and exit, along Solihull Parkway, off Northway Island from 8pm on Friday 13 August, through to 5am on Monday 16 August. Throughout the closure, access to the park will be maintained via Progress Way off the B4438.

Key:

-  = closed Birmingham Business Park entrance and exit off Northway Island
-  = accessible Birmingham Business Park entrance and exit off the B4438
