High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at HS2inCamden.co.uk.

### Update: white line removal on Prince Albert Road – rescheduled for 28 July

In May we repainted the white lines on Prince Albert Road to indicate the new traffic lights and crossing. At the time we were unable to remove the existing white lines and painted over them as a temporary measure. We will return to remove the old road markings on 28 July, not 27 July, as previously notified.

We will require alternating lane and footway closures and temporary traffic management on Prince Albert Road to safely carry out these works.

### Update: traffic light adjustment on Prince Albert Road – postponed

### Weekend works within Camden Cutting worksite - August & September

For safety, we can only carry out works next to the tracks during a rail closure when trains are not operating.

We will carry out works onsite between Mornington Street bridge and Granby Terrace, during the weekends of 7 to 8 August, 14 to 15 August (including overnight works) and 4 to 5 September. We will move the safety barrier between our worksite and the tracks to clear the working area and excavate to prepare for sheet piling. We will also remove a concrete platform beside the railway tracks.

We will use acoustic blankets to limit noise and will monitor our works 24/7 to ensure the noise level remains within the limits agreed with the local council. We will limit noisy works such as concrete breaking to Saturday, with quieter works overnight and on Sunday.

Our working hours will be Saturday and Sunday 8am to 9pm. We will work overnight during the second weekend only, from 14 to 15 August.

### Vibratory sheet piling trial within Camden Cutting worksite – 9 to 13 August

In September, we need to remove a section of sheet piling within our worksite between Mornington Street bridge and Granby Terrace. We have been using this piling to support the walls of a large trench excavation.

We plan to remove these sheet piles by pulling them up out of the ground using a quiet, non-vibrating rig. However, if a pile is stuck, we may need to use a vibratory method to loosen the sheet pile before lifting it out of the ground.

Before we start removing these sheet piles in September, we will carry out a trial for a week in August to test these methods and help identify any additional measures to reduce the impacts of these planned works.

During the trial – from 9 to 13 August, during core hours – we will use the vibratory sheet piling machine to remove a section of sheet piling between Mornington Street bridge and Granby Terrace. We will monitor these works closely to ensure we remain within the noise and vibration limits agreed with the local council.

# Borehole and ground monitoring equipment install on Park Village East – 9 to 20 August


We will install a new borehole and ground water monitoring equipment within the footway and carriageway on Park Village East to continue monitoring groundwater levels in this area. We will use a small rig to drill a borehole in the carriageway, before installing the ground monitoring equipment and securing the opening to the borehole. We will keep dust to a minimum and limit noise by using acoustic blankets.

We will require a lane and footway closure and parking bay suspensions on Park Village East to carry out these works. Please see the map below for details.

### Trial holes for utilities connections to worksite – 16 August to 3 September

We need to create electricity and sewer connections from next to 1 Park Village East down to our track-level worksite at the northern end of the Euston Approaches. The electricity connection requires a street-level substation, which will be installed and owned by UKPN. Before we start these utilities connections, we will carry out trial holes from 16 August to 3 September to check for the location of existing utilities.

The trial holes will be within the carriageway and require a lane and footway closure and parking bay suspensions as shown on the map below.
