


Notice of temporary access arrangements for Proof House Business Park

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and Murphy & Sons known as LM.

Access to Proof House Business Park will be via New Canal Street

To carry out the ongoing utility works safely, we need to manage traffic in the local area. This will include temporarily changing the access arrangements to **Proof House Business Park** from w/c Monday 19 July for approximately four weeks. Please see below for more information.

What to expect

Access to Proof House Business via the secondary access on New Canal Street.

Traffic and pedestrian management measures will be in place as we carry out the ongoing works.

Core working hours are 8am to 6pm, although staff may be on site up to an hour before and an hour after those times.

What we will do

Clearly signpost the diversion route and pedestrian management and explain these changes to road users and pedestrians.

Keep disruption to a minimum.
