

# Update: Notice of piling works at our site on Breakspear Road South

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19.

## Work update

We wrote to you in June to advise you that we would be starting the next phase of the bored piles installation at Breakspear Road South from 21 June to 31 July. However, we will require additional time to complete these works which will continue until 6 August 2021.

We will also be installing sheet piles within our site compound at the same time.

## What we are doing

We will be carrying out bored and sheet piles at our Breakspear Road South site. These works will stabilise the ground while we build the over bridge at this location.

- Bored piles are a commonly used form of foundation that provide support for structures. It is an effective approach to combating corrosion and is proven to significantly improve the life expectancy of a structure.
- Sheet piles are commonly used for retaining walls and underground structures to provide stability and support during excavation works. Steel sheet piles will be installed side by side along the perimeter and pressed into position.

We do not anticipate any disruption from these works.

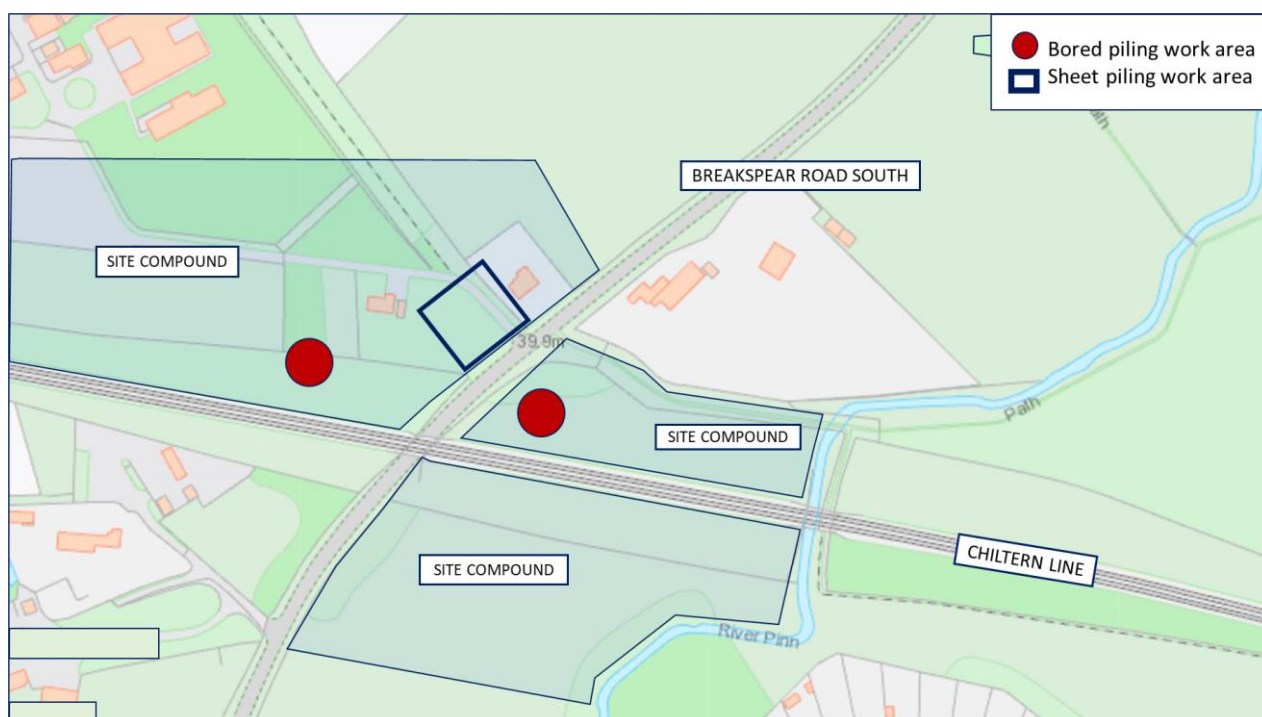
