High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.

Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. We have postponed all face-to-face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities, such as letters and phone calls, as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites. What will we be doing?

As part of our continuing works ahead of the construction of the railway we need to undertake some further works in your area.

- Full road closure
- **Ecology mitigation**
- Vegetation clearance

Ecology mitigation and full road closure

Following on from the earlier advised bat surveys we are continuing our established programme of bat mitigation works. To complete the bat mitigation and to enable this to happen safely we need to put a road closure in place.

Main Street (The Green), Chetwode

23 August 2021 to 27 August 2021

Ecology mitigation and full road closure continued

The road closure will allow ecologists to safely observe and where necessary climb roadside trees to check for habitat. Subject to the outcome of these further surveys tree limbs / trees may be felled at this time. In addition to this bat boxes will be installed in specific locations. The programme and road closure location are below:

Road Closure – Main Street (The Green)

23 August 2021 to 27 August 2021

Daily 9.30am until 3.30pm

The road will be open as usual outside of these hours.

To notify road users of the upcoming road closure, verge advance warning signs will be erected.

Advance warning signs will be installed on both direction of the closure points on all junctions.

The diversion signage will be in place and operated during the working hours described, these signs will be mounted on standard A frames and secured with ballasted sandbags.

Details of the road closure and diversion routes can be found on the map enclosed.

Vegetation clearance

Whilst the road closure is in place, we need to complete a section of hedgerow removal on Main Street (The Green). This removal is required as it will create a works access and will include fencing off a work area.

The road will be open as usual outside of these hours.

How will this affect you?

We will be working hard to ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these and all our future works. You may notice a little extra traffic on the road immediately around the sites with workers and delivery vehicles moving to and from the site. There may be some noise from the machinery. All machinery will be restricted to running between the hours of 8am to 6pm.


