

Temporary weekend road closures - Long Itchington Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Temporary road closures on Long Itchington Road

As part of the Fosse Way highway realignment scheme, LM will be temporarily closing a section of Long Itchington Road (National Cycle Rte. 41) over three weekends in September from 8.00am on Saturday through to 6.00pm on Sunday. The reason for each closure is to install utility crossings. The dates of the closures are as follows:

Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 September Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 September Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 September

Access will still be maintained for pedestrians, cyclists, households and businesses along the route and a clearly signposted diversion will be in place (see map below). All works are subject to consent, site, and weather conditions.

BBV and WPD are also at work in the area

Balfour Beatty Vinci (BBV) will also have a section of Long Itchington Road closed 24/7, 7 days a week from 26 August until 15 October on the opposite side of the Fosse Way to construct a heavy plant crossing to facilitate earth works in the area. Western Power Distribution (WPD) will be carrying out utility works on Long Itchington Road/Snowford Hill between 16 August and 4 September.

The map below highlights both LM and BBV closures and the diversion routes in place.

Access to properties

If your property frontage is within the closure points, we will work with you to manage access into and out of your property. You may sometimes experience a short delay whilst we move machinery or create a safe path within the closed area during our working hours.


