











Vehicle Holding Area/ Parkway (SCS)

Lane closures on Parkway – 13 to 31 October 2025

To inform the design of our utility works on Parkway, we need to survey a Cadent Gas main. we will dig a trial hole in the carriageway on Parkway. We will close the middle two lanes on Parkway to complete these works.

Before we dig the trial hole, we need to complete a survey in the carriageway to assess the ground below. We will use the same traffic management as required for the trial hole. We do not expect this survey to be noisy.

Duration of works: 13 to 14 October (overnight), 20 to 31 October (core hours) including 25 to 26 October 2025 (weekend working)

Traffic impact

- Two middle lanes closed on Parkway
- Traffic will continue to flow on outer two lanes.

Footpath closure on Gloucester Avenue – 23 and 24 October 2025

We need to assess and backfill a borehole in the footpath on Gloucester Avenue ahead of the tunnel-boring machine (TBM) passing through the area.

We will fill in a borehole on Gloucester Avenue and reinstate the area with paving slabs. There may be periods of increased noise, but we will place acoustic barriers around the borehole to minimise impacts.


Duration of works: 23 and 24 October

Traffic impact

- Partial footpath closure
- Acoustic barriers around the area

Camden Cutting (SCS)

Mornington Street bridge reopened

We reopened Mornington Street bridge to vehicles on 8 January 2024. We have put a 3-tonne weight limit in place which we are managing with width restriction barriers at both end of the bridge.

For safety reasons, Network Rail and SCS will continue to monitor the bridge whilst work continues beneath it.


Please note the bridge will be closed throughout the duration of tunnelling works and we will update you in advance. These are expected to take 5 years to complete.

Traffic impact

- Mornington Street bridge reopened to vehicle traffic with 3-ton weight limit
- Access maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

Euston Throat (SCS)

Update: Road closure on Varndell Street – 4 October to 3 November 2025


From February to September 2025, we will close Varndell Street and divert vehicles via Robert Street. Cardington Street will also be closed due to MDjv works.

Duration of works: 19 February 2025 to 3 November 2025 Traffic impacts:

- Road closure on Varndell Street (vehicles diverted via Robert Street)
- Northbound and southbound lane closures
- Cardington Street closed
- Footpath closure and diversion on Hampstead Road

- 20 June 2025

Hampstead Road utilities diversion – 10 September to 6 October 2025

During this next phase, we will continue to close one outside northbound lane and two outside southbound lanes on Hampstead Road.

Pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained around the work site and into Ampthill Estate. We will continue to monitor the traffic management and reduce impacts where possible. We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause.

Duration of works: 10 September to 6 October 2025

Traffic impacts:

- Southbound and northbound lane closures on Hampstead Road
- Pedestrians and cycle access will be maintained

Hampstead Road utilities diversion (next phase) – 6 to 31 October 2025

From 6 to 31 October, we will continue to close one outside northbound lane and one outside southbound lane on Hampstead Road.

We will also dig a trial hole in the eastern footpath on Hampstead Road.

We will partially close the footpath and divert pedestrians up and around the closure to ensure access to the Ampthill Estate is maintained.

Duration of works: 6 to 31 October 2025

Traffic impacts:

- Southbound and northbound lane closures on Hampstead Road
- Pedestrian diversion for Ampthill Estate
- Pedestrians and cycle access will be maintained

Lane closure on Stanhope Street – 11 August to 10 October 2025

We need to install UKPN ducts in the road and footpath outside our site access gate at the junction of Stanhope Street and Park Village East, opposite Cubitt Court.

Current phase: 11 August to 10 October 2025

Traffic impacts:

- Lane closure opposite Cubitt Court
- 2-way set of temporary traffic lights
- Pedestrians and cycle access will be maintained with crossing points

Euston Station works (MDjv)

North Gower Street Gas Main diversion Phase One - 14

April to 23 December 2025

We will be carrying out gas main diversions in North Gower Street and Euston Street over three phases.

We are now on phase two of these works which is taking place on North Gower Street.

Traffic impact:

- Lane closure on North Gower Street
- Traffic controlled by temporary signals
- No vehicular access to Euston Road

Worksites:

Drummond Street Gas Replacement Works – 18 August to December 2025

We will be carrying out gas main replacement on Drummond Street from Monday 18 August 2025. There will be two sites on Drummond Street – one at the junction with North Gower Street and one within our hoarding at the end of the road. The technique used is an insertion which negates the need for a full excavation of the road

Traffic impact:

Road closed to vehicles for 12 weeks from 18 August 2025

Notification Sent:

30 May 2025

Eversholt Street surveys and trial holes – 23 September 2025 to 31 January 2026

We will be conducting utility surveys to inform planned future works in the area. To facilitate these works, bus stops A and B on Eversholt Street will be suspended intermittently.

Following the completion of these surveys we will undertake relocation and construction of major utilities works.

Traffic impact:

- Localised lane and road closures
- 2-way set of temporary traffic lights
- Parking bays and loading bays suspensions
- Footway restrictions.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
