

Parkway utility works – February to August 2026

Parkway utility works

We need to protect and divert utility services beneath Parkway junction and in the surrounding area before we begin tunnelling. From February to August, we will carry out utility works on the sewers, water mains and power cables on Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street.


In autumn 2026, we will return to Parkway to complete protective works to the Cadent Gas main.

- Lane closures

Camden Cutting (SCS)



Mornington Street bridge reopened

We reopened Mornington Street bridge to vehicles on 8 January 2024. We have put a 3-tonne weight limit in place which we are managing with width restriction barriers at both end of the bridge.

For safety reasons, Network Rail and SCS will continue to monitor the bridge whilst work continues beneath it.


Please note the bridge will be closed throughout the duration of tunnelling works and we will update you in advance. These are expected to take 5 years to complete.

Traffic impact

- Mornington Street bridge reopened to vehicle traffic with 3-ton weight limit
- Access maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

Planter maintenance on Park Village East - from 2 to 6 February 2026

From Monday 2 February, we will be pouring water mixed with non-harmful drain tracing dye into the section of the planter 22 to 26 Park Village East to identify all the drainage holes in the Park Village East wall and ensure they are working.

We will need to use equipment to remove material from the planter before pouring water into the existing drainage. We expect this activity to take approximately three days to complete. We will work from Monday to Friday during core hours, from 8am to 6pm.

Euston Throat (SCS)



Lane and footpath closures on Hampstead Road - until late February

We previously informed you of utility diversion works on Hampstead Road south of Cardington Street. These works were due to be complete on 6 February.

Due to a clash with Mace Dragados JV hoarding works, we will now complete these works on 27 February. We will close the southbound lane on Hampstead Road near Varndell.

The footpath on Hampstead Road near Cardington Street will be closed, and pedestrians will be diverted through the carriageway and worksite. Vehicle access to Regent's Park estate will be via Robert Street.

Duration of works: Ongoing until 27 February 2026

Traffic impacts:

- Northbound and southbound lane closures
- Cardington Street closed
- Footpath closure and diversion on Hampstead Road

Hampstead Road utilities diversion – February to end of March

From 2 February to 31 March 2026, we will close the footpath and nearside lane on Hampstead Road, and pedestrians will be diverted around the closure.

We will use the same traffic management to carry out trial holes in this area to inform our utility works design when we return utilities back onto Hampstead Road following the bridge extension.

From 9 February till 31 March, we will close a lane on Lidlington Place near Eversholt Street and install temporary traffic lights at the junction for cable pulling works. The pedestrian crossings will be maintained.

Duration of works: 2 February to 31 March 2026

Traffic impacts:



Cable pulling works – December to February 2026

Working area in Ampthill Estate near Oxenholme and Gillfoot

From **1 to 19 December**, we will require a small working area in Ampthill Estate, outside Oxenholme and Gillfoot. We will fence off the area and divert pedestrians around our works.

Northbound lane closure on Hampstead Road

From **5 January to 11 February 2026**, we will close one northbound lane on Hampstead Road while we pull cables over Granby Terrace bridge.

Install of new site access door – from 31 January to 1 February 2026



Eversholt Street surveys and trial holes – 23 September 2025 to 31 January 2026

We will be conducting utility surveys to inform planned future works in the area. To facilitate these works, bus stops A and B on Eversholt Street will be suspended intermittently.

Following the completion of these surveys we will undertake relocation and construction of major utilities works.

Traffic impact:

- Localised lane and road closures
- 2-way set of temporary traffic lights
- Parking bays and loading bays suspensions
- Footway restrictions
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times

HS2 Euston Station Main Site Work


We will be continuing our constructing a retaining wall using piling and concrete techniques. All works will take place within our hoardings and there may be periods of increased noise during this activity.

Hampstead Road - Watermain - 2 Feb - 2 March


Completion of 16 inch Watermain installation and final commissioning.

Melton Street - Piling - 9 Feb - late March


We will be carrying out overnight Piling works between 10pm to 5:30am each day.
