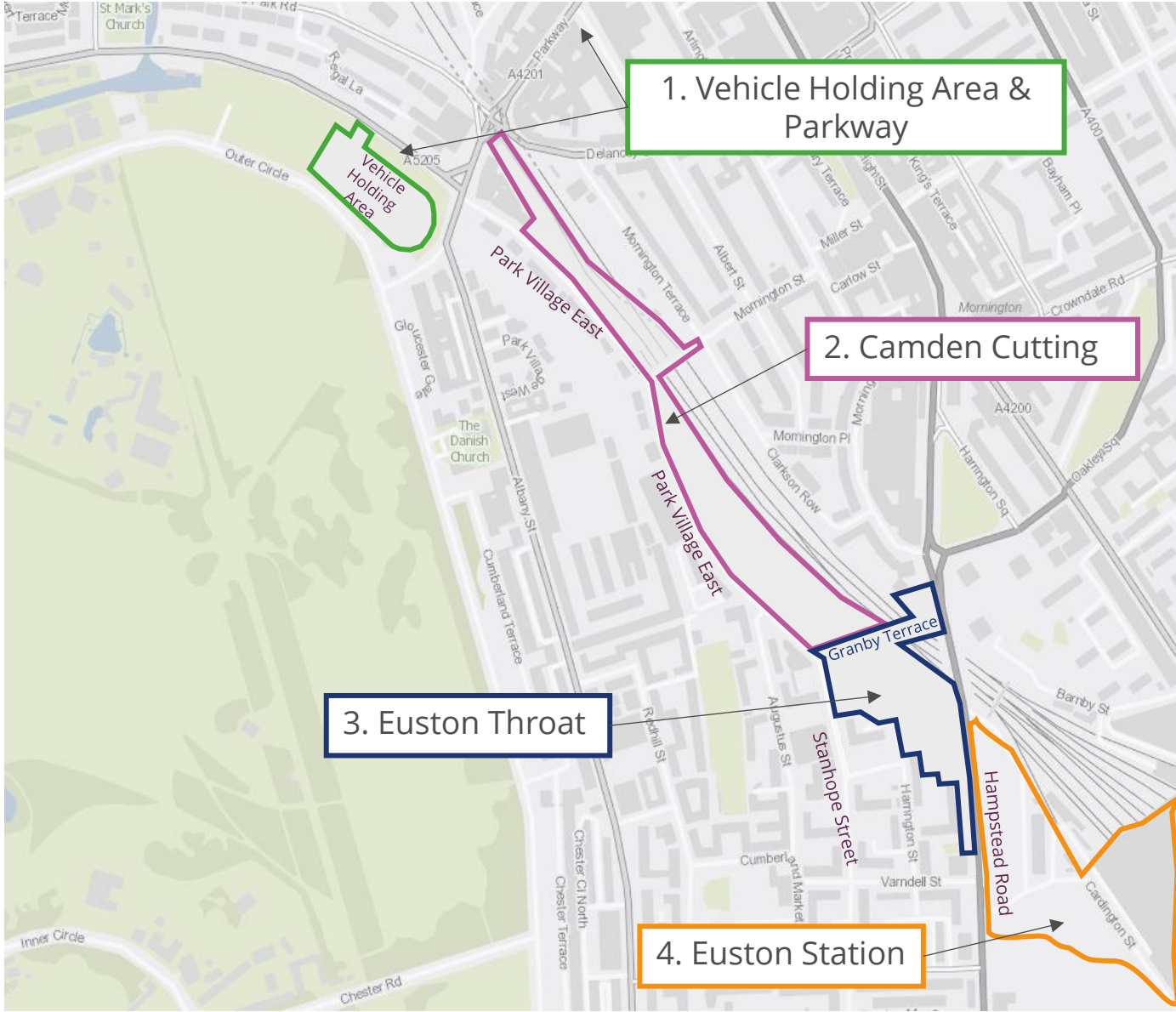

# Parkway utility works – February to October 2026

We need to protect and divert utility services beneath Parkway junction and in the surrounding area before we begin tunnelling. From February to September, we will carry out utility works on the sewers, water mains and power cables on Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street.

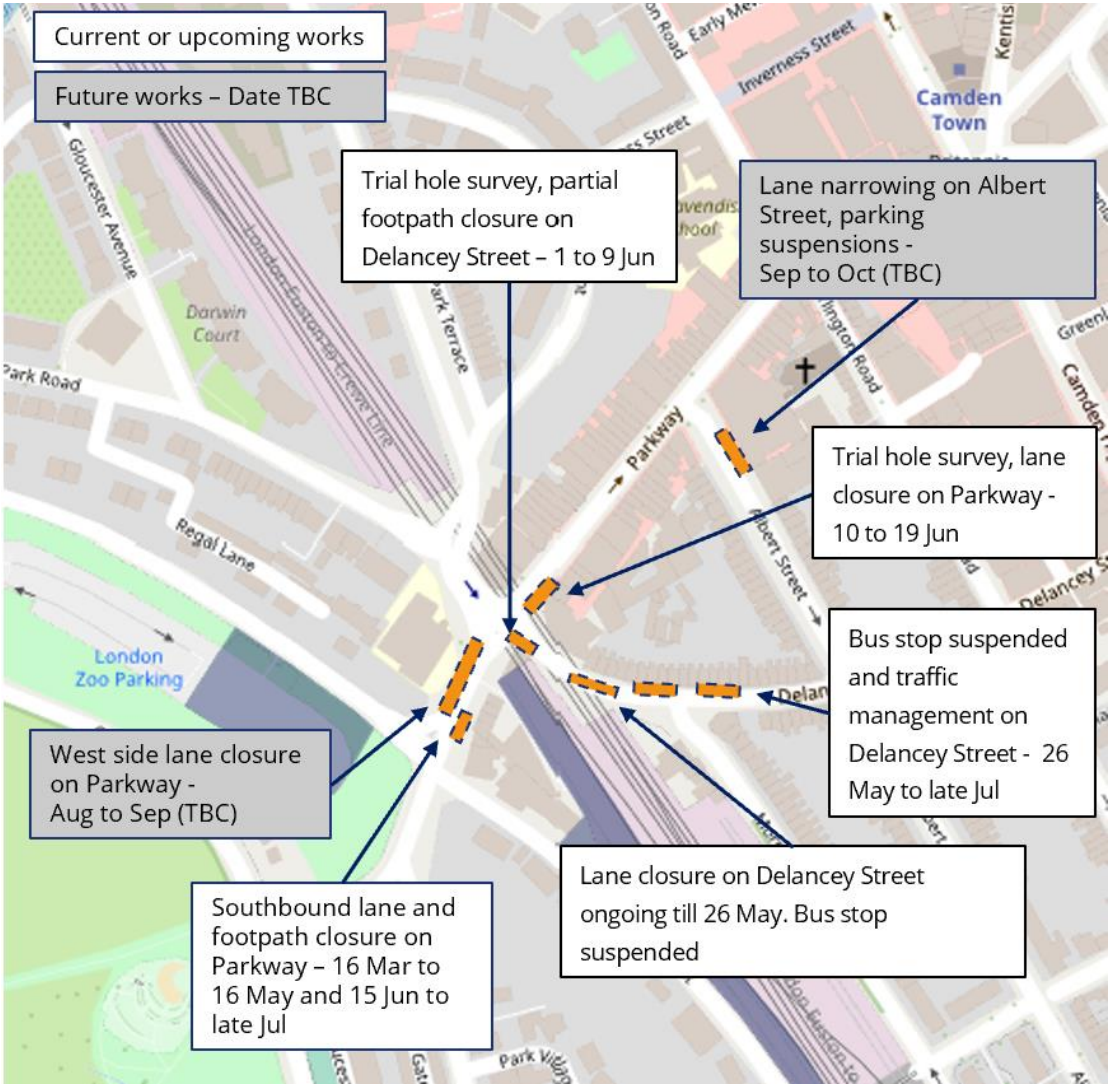
In autumn 2026, we will return to Parkway to complete protective works to the Cadent Gas main.

**Traffic impact**

- Road closure at junction of Delancey Street and Mornington Terrace
- Lane and footpath closures
- Parking bay suspensions

# Mornington Street bridge reopened

We reopened Mornington Street bridge to vehicles on 8 January 2024. We have put a 3-tonne weight limit in place which we are managing with width restriction barriers at both end of the bridge.

For safety reasons, Network Rail and SCS will continue to monitor the bridge whilst work continues beneath it.

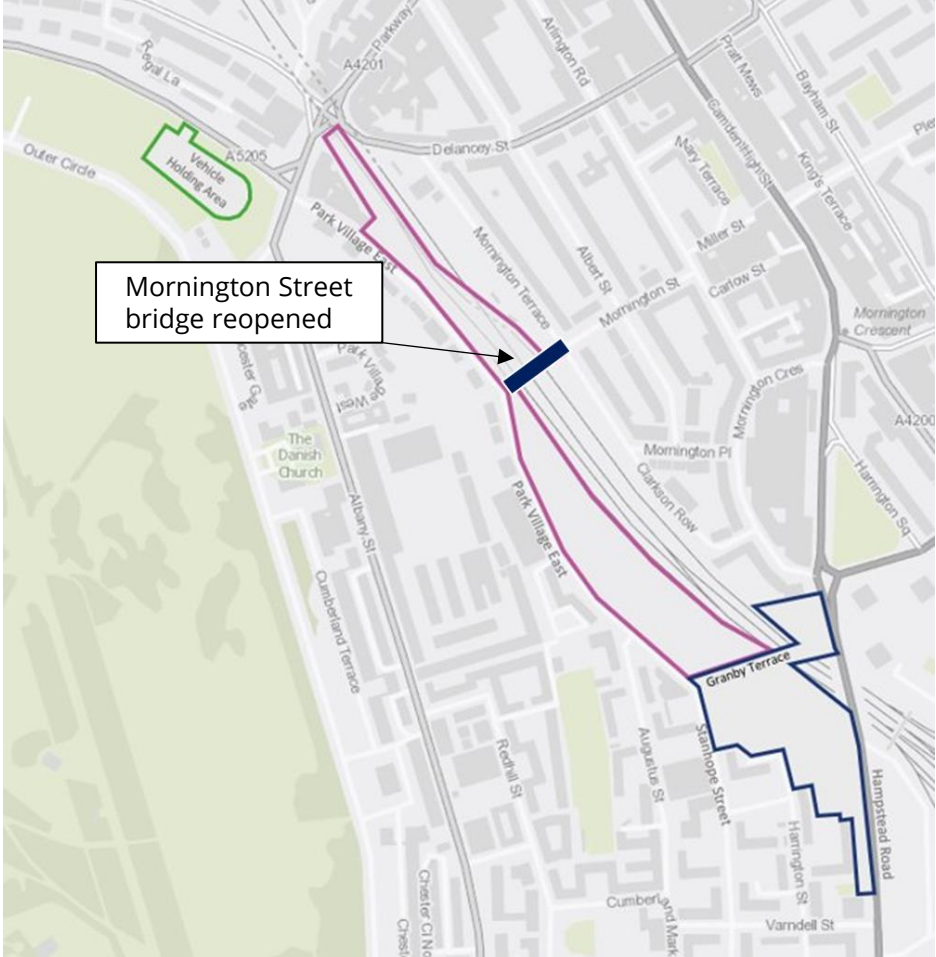
Please note the bridge will be closed throughout the duration of tunnelling works and we will update you in advance. These are expected to take 5 years to complete.

### Traffic impact

- Mornington Street bridge reopened to vehicle traffic with 3-ton weight limit
- Access maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

# Footpath and cycle lane closure on Hampstead Road, north of Robert Street – 26 to 30 May

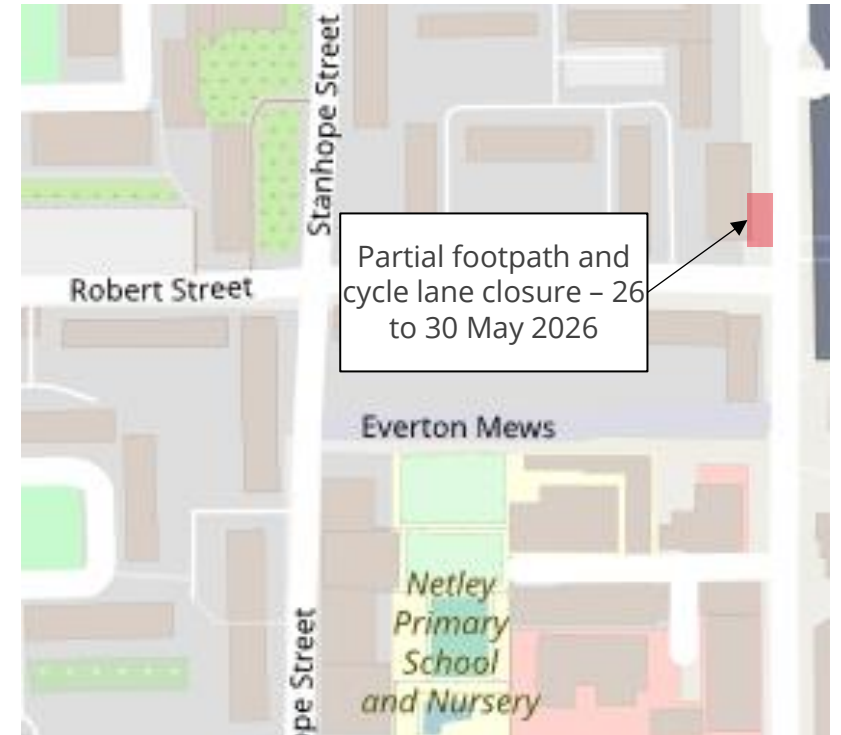
From 11 May, we will dig a trial hole in the western footpath on Hampstead Road, north of Robert Street. We'll hand dig, survey, and reinstate the area. We expect these works to be completed by 15 May. We apologise for the inconvenience these works may cause.

- Pedestrian and cyclist diversion around closure

# Southbound cycle lane and footpath closure on Hampstead Road, south of Cardington Street – 4 May onwards

In preparation for Mace Dragados' (MDjv) Western Utility Road programme, which will run parallel to Hampstead Road (within site), we need to construct some British Telecommunications (BT) chambers in the southbound cycle lane and footpath. We will start these works on 4 May and will continue until October 2026.

**Duration of works: 4 May until October 2026**

- Pedestrians and cyclists will be diverted around the closure
