
## **Notice of construction of** conveyor haul road

HS2 will be constructing a conveyor system to move material from the Old Oak Common station site as well as the Victoria Road Crossover Box site to the Willesden Euroterminal site as part of our plan to reduce HGV traffic on the local road network. In preparation of the conveyor installation, BBVS will carry out works on the existing Wycombe Line bridge and construct a haul road through the satellite sites to the south and west of Wells House Road. This will provide access for the construction plant and equipment required to build the conveyor.

#### **Wycombe Line Bridge Adaptation**

From 13 September 2021 for one week, we will undertake works on the Wycombe Line Bridge. This will convert the current rail bridge into a road bridge which will allow construction vehicles to travel from Old Oak Common Station to the satellite site to the South of Wells House Road in order to install the conveyor. We will begin by installing concrete barriers along the bridge. Aggregate materials will then be delivered by tipper trucks and spread upon the bridge by excavators. Once these materials have been spread, they will be compacted by rollers to create the temporary road.

#### **Duration of works**

From 13 September to mid-October 2021 on Mondays to Fridays from 8am to 6pm and on Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

#### What to expect

There will be plant and machinery on the Wycombe Line Bridge and on the satellite sites bordering Wells House Road. You may notice an increase in noise levels while earth is compacted to form the haul road however this will be done in short spells to minimise disruption.

#### What we will do

We will use best practicable means to minimise any impact on our site neighbours.

#### Haul road installation

Following completion of bridge works, we will begin building a haul road in the satellite site to the south of Wells House Road, in the area marked in blue on the map below. This will provide access for the installation of the conveyor later in the year. There will be minor excavation works to flatten the area. Tipper trucks will then deliver aggregate materials which will be spread by excavators to create the temporary road. The earth will then be compacted using rollers to ensure the Haul Road is suitable for use.

The compacting will be done in short spells to minimise disruption to properties in the local area. After the road has been completed, site setup will commence. This will include the installation of fencing and barriers to secure the area. The installation of the haul road within the satellite sites will take approximately three weeks.

All work will be undertaken from 8am to 6pm on Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. During these works, water sprays will be used to prevent an increase in dust levels. We will be undertaking air quality and noise monitoring throughout these works to ensure the dust and noise levels do not exceed the current permitted levels.

Following the haul road installation, works will begin to install the conveyor foundations in these satellite sites. We will keep you notified about these works as they progress.
