High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Temporary traffic lights on the Fosse Way

Following the recent opening of the new roundabout at the Fosse Way/Welsh Road junction, the realigned section of Welsh Road between The Fosse Way and Offchurch was also opened on 19 December 2021. The section of Welsh Road between the Bascote and the Fosse Way will remain closed until the end of January 2022.

In preparation for the next phase of works for the second roundabout at the Fosse Way/Long Itchington Road junction, LM will need to install temporary traffic lights along a short section of the Fosse Way on Tuesday 4 January until mid-March 2022 (please see map below). The reason for the temporary traffic lights is to create a safe working zone for our workforce when working in that area to install draining and utilities etc.

This timeframe is subject to consents so please do check on the road signs – any changes will be published on the **hs2inwarwickshire** website. For live traffic information please go-to **one.network**.

Duration of works

4 January to mid-March 2022

Temporary lights erected when required between 9:30am and 3:30pm.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 8am to 6pm, and Saturday and Sunday, 8am to 6pm.

Dates may be subject to change due to consents and site conditions.

We may be on site for up to one hour before or after those times, to set up or pack up.

What to expect

Some noise from on-site machinery during working hours.

Potential minor delays during peak traffic.
