Notice of temporary traffic management, Small Dean, Wendover

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. All sites will remain under constant review. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inbucksandox.co.uk.

What are we doing?

As our works continue to progress, we have been acquiring and taking possession of land along the line of route for various site preparation and construction activities. During these possessions, we have been installing fencing, removing vegetation and clearing the site in preparation for works activities.

Where are we working?

We will be working in the Small Dean area of Wendover on a section of land adjacent to the A413 and near the existing Network Rail line.

For reasons of safety, these works will require temporary traffic management along the A413, London Road and a closure along Small Dean Lane for a period of time over the coming days.

This traffic management will allow us to fence and secure the area of HS2 possessed land while we undertake site clearance and preparation work for the Small Dean viaduct.

When will these works take place?

Our works to secure the area will start from Sunday 10th October 2021.

Some of our work is within close proximity to the existing Chiltern Rail Line. This means it is necessary for some work to be completed outside of our core working hours to allow for safe working access in and around the rail line.

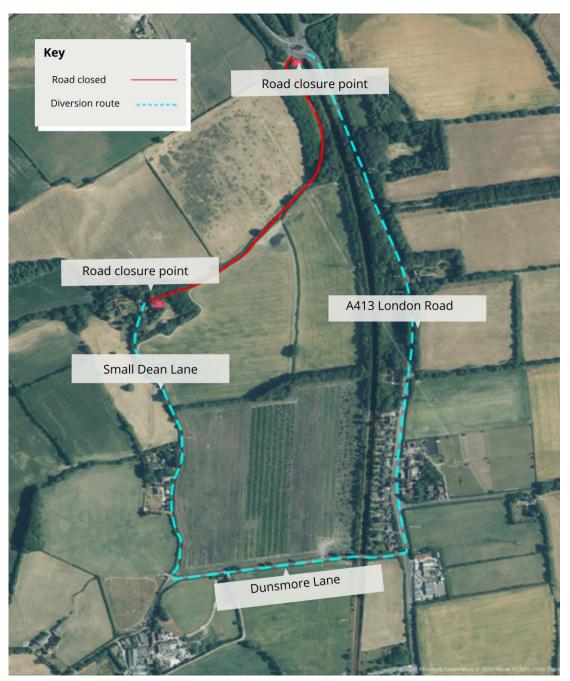
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Will there be road diversions in place?

There will be a lane closure with traffic lights placed along the A413 so there will still be access north to Wendover and south to Great Missenden.

Small Dean Lane will be under a full temporary closure from the A413 roundabout. Local access will be from Dunsmore Lane. The map below illustrates the intended diversion route.
