High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

Subject to consents we will be implementing a long-term single lane traffic management system on the M42/M6 link road westbound to enable our works for the M42/M6 link viaduct.

In order for us to implement the single lane traffic management safely, we will implement full overnight closures of the M42/M6 link road westbound from Wednesday 10 November until Monday 15 November. Our working hours will be from 9.00pm to 5.00am.

Once the single traffic management is in place, we will begin utility works and the installation of welfare facilities. The single lane traffic management will be in place until Summer 2023.

HS2 during the COVID-19 pandemic

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with the Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with coronavirus. The Government's current coronavirus strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we affect is our key priority. Please be assured that those sites that are currently still working are doing so because they can operate within PHE and construction industry guidelines.

- Overnight closures will take place from 10 November – 15 November
- Working hours are 9pm – 5am
- The single lane traffic management will be in place throughout our works
- These dates are subject to consents, weather and site conditions

- Our workforce on site 1 hour before and after to set up and take down equipment



The works will take place on the M42/M6 link road on the westbound carriageway. The location of work is highlighted in red below.




