



Update on works, full road closure on Radstone Road, Brackley

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. Further to the Covid-19 restrictions being relaxed we are now beginning to plan for future face-to-face engagement events and meetings. Whilst we continue to move forward, we will continue to communicate with communities via letters, online meetings and phone calls. What will be doing?

Now that we have completed all surveys works, we need to undertake a series of mitigation works in accordance with the ecological seasonal calendar. To enable this to happen safely over two days we will need to have a full road closure between 09.30am until 3.30pm. This is to allow ecologists to safely observe and where necessary climb roadside trees to check before felling. The programme and temporary roadblock location are below.

- **Full road closure**

Radstone Road, Brackley

27 & 28 October 2021

9.30am until 3.30pm

The road will be open as usual outside of these hours.

What will we be doing continued,

Please note we may not require the full 2 days to complete the mitigation works.

To notify road users of the upcoming full road closure, verge advance warning signs will be erected.

The diversion signage will be in place and operated during the working hours described, however road closed signs will be removed when non-working hours resume. These signs will be mounted on standard A frames and secured with ballasted sandbags.

How may this affect you?

We will be working hard to ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these and all our future works. You may notice a little extra traffic on the road immediately around the sites with workers and delivery vehicles moving to and from the site. There may be some noise from the machinery. All machinery will be restricted to running between the hours of 8am to 6pm.
