



Update to the Temporary closure of Park Lane, off Cappers Lane notice

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

To maintain a safe area for construction staff, there will be a temporary closure of Park Lane.

These works are required to create two new entrances to our compound.

The work undertaken will include preparation of the road edges and laying of new kerb stones.

Within our compound area, we will construct a haul road which will be used by our construction vehicles. Haul roads are temporary roads provided within a working area to allow for the movement of construction materials, constructions machinery and/or construction staff around the site. Haul roads are Balfour Beatty Vinci's preferred logistical transport link, as they reduce the number of vehicles interfering with the existing local road network and provide the greatest possible control over works activity.

When will we do these works?

Due to poor weather conditions these works have had to be extended from Friday 8 October 2021 4:00pm until Wednesday October 13 6:00pm 2021 this will include the weekend.

Our hours of work will be 8:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 9:00am to 1:00pm Saturday. Our workforce can be on site for one hour before and after to set up and take down our equipment. The road will be closed 24 hours a day seven days a week due to safety reasons.

There will be a diversion in place - see the map.

Duration of works

These works will be extended from Friday 8 October 2021 4:00pm until Wednesday 13 October 2021 6:00pm.

The road will be closed 24/7 for the duration of these works.

Our working hours will be 8:00am to 6:00pm weekdays and 9:00am to 1:00pm Saturday.

Our workforce can be on site one hour before and after to set up and take down work equipment.

What to expect

Delivery of equipment and materials to and from the works area.

Some noise will be generated from the work.

What we will do

Inform you in advance of any changes to the date shown.

Keep all sites safe and secure.

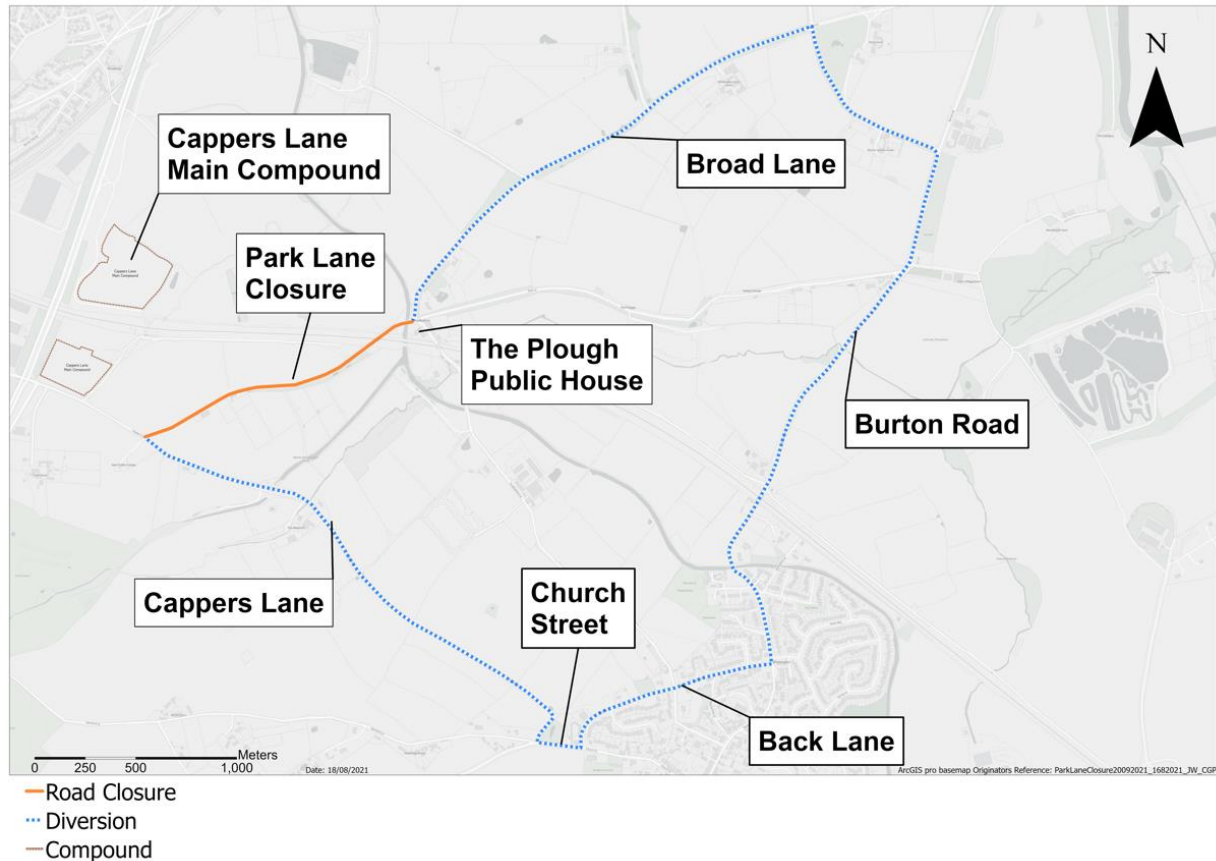
