

## Notice of road closure, Banbury Road, Lower Boddington

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. Further to the Covid-19 restrictions being relaxed we are now beginning to plan for future face-to-face engagement events and meetings. Whilst we continue to move forward, we will still continue to communicate with communities via letters, online meetings and phone calls. ### What we will be doing?

Following on from the earlier completed ecology surveys and bat/ecology mitigation on Phase 5 of our works in your area (Banbury Road), we need to return to this section to remove some felled trees which we were unable to complete within the original closure. To enable us to complete this work safely we need close **Banbury Road** once for up to 15 minutes and will take place between the hours of 10am and 2pm.

#### Thursday 9 December 2021 between 10am and 2pm

This is subject to final consents and approval from the Local Authority.

The road will be open as normal after this time.

Please see enclosed map for location of road closure.

Further to our recent works in the area we are required to install wooden post and rail fencing in the areas of tree hedgerow removal, to minimise disruption we plan to do this from inside the field, however, there may be occasions when this is not possible and we may require the use of local traffic management. We will keep you updated if this is required.
