Work on behalf of HS2 Ltd – 'stop' and 'go' boards on Chorlton Lane from 28 February until mid-October 2022

Thank you for your understanding with our ongoing project work. I'm getting in touch to provide a further update regarding traffic management in the area.

We'll lift the closure of Chorlton Lane a little earlier than planned. Instead of 3 March as previously communicated, it will now be open to motorists from Friday 25 February.

For the remainder of the project works, we'll use 'stop' and 'go' boards (or similar) on Chorlton Lane to control local traffic during deliveries to and from our site. This will take effect from 28 February until mid-October. We kindly request motorists wait in one of the passing bays when we receive deliveries. Our contractors will use a radio system to aid traffic flow.

The use of 'stop' and 'go' boards means we're able to keep Chorlton Lane open, and we won't need to divert traffic along Waybutt Lane and Newcastle Road, while we carry out the gas pipeline diversion works on behalf of HS2 Limited.
