High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. Further to the Covid-19 restrictions being relaxed we are now beginning to plan for future face-to-face engagement events and meetings. Whilst we continue to move forward, we will continue to communicate with communities via letters, online meetings and phone calls. What will we be doing?

Now that we have completed all surveys works, we are undertaking a series of mitigation works in accordance with the ecological seasonal calendar. To enable this to happen safely we may need to have a temporary roadblock for up to 15 minutes every hour between 09.30am until 3.30pm. This is to allow ecologists to safely observe and where necessary climb roadside trees to check before felling. The programme and temporary roadblock location are below.


