Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. Further to the Covid-19 restrictions being relaxed we are now beginning to plan for future face-to-face engagement events and meetings. Whilst we continue to move forward, we will continue to communicate with communities via letters, online meetings and phone calls. What will we be doing?

Since we last updated you in September 2021, we are now contacting you to let you know what works we have remaining for Trafford Bridge Marsh until spring 2022.

Tree / vegetation clearance

This work is ongoing until mid-November 2021

Welsh Road closure

Full Road closure between 09.30am until 3.00pm in Spring 2022 (more details to follow closer to the time)

Marshland translocation (subject to final consents)

Mid November until Spring 2022

Ahead of the translocation works we will need to stockpile aggregate that will be used as part of the works. To complete this work HGVs will make aggregate deliveries to the site between mid-November 2021 and January 2022 between the hours of 9am and 4pm. Access will be made directly from the A361 turning off at the junction along Welsh Road.

Ongoing work until Spring 2022

What to expect

To complete this work, we need to; complete ecology surveys, clear vegetation, undertake planting and transfer marshland turf.

Road closures on Welsh Road with diversion routes.

Stockpile aggregate ahead of the translocation work.

You may notice some extra traffic on the roads and noise from the machinery. Our normal working hours are between 8:00am and 6:00pm Monday – Friday and Saturday 8:00am – 1:00pm
