High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Thames Water update

To make way to the new HS2 railway line we need to carry out some laser surveys and monitor our sewer via manholes on **Oval Road, Plender Street** and **St Mark's Square.**

Our work

During the week commencing Monday 22 November until Saturday 27 November, we will be at each location for three consecutive nights.

Oval Road

We will be working in the section of Oval Road, opposite the southern entrance to Gloucester Crescent. We will need to suspend two parking bays and there will be temporary traffic lights in place.

Plender Street

We will be working in the section of Plender Street, by the junction with Camden Street. We will need to suspend up to three parking bays and there will be traffic lights will be in place on the junction to keep the road open

St Marks Square

We will be working in the section of St. Mark's Square by the junction with Prince Albert Road and there will traffic lights in place to keep the road open
