Work on behalf of HS2 Ltd - update regarding work near Chorlton

As you're aware, the new HS2 railway will pass above one of our existing gas pipelines at Chorlton, between Audley and Nantwich. To ensure it continues to operate safely and reliably, we need to divert a 370m long section of the pipeline.

We started preparatory work at the start of the year and were due to begin tunnelling activity in the summer. Work of this nature is highly complex and before we started, we encountered some technical challenges on the site. This delayed our progress and resulted in us temporarily pausing our work and demobilising from the site.

We've worked closely with our contractor on a revised design and programme over the last couple of months. I wanted to let you know that we've restarted our work at the site.

Several Public Rights of Way (PRoW) will remain closed in the interest of safety of users of these routes. Footpaths Chorlton FP7 (section between Chorlton FP8 and FP9), FP12 and FP13 pass through our site and they'll remain closed until we've completed our work. Notices have been posted at each end and on connecting footpaths. We have permission from Cheshire East Council and Staffordshire County Council for the closures and diversions.

Due to the delays on-site, we now expect to complete our works around winter 2023. However, this is subject to change to fit with the activities of other HS2 contractors.

We've written to those who live closest to the site about our work and given them our Community Relations number should they have any questions.
