



Notice of A38 Streethay, Staffordshire overnight closures in January 2022

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We are constructing a bridge to take the A38 over the HS2 line. During the parliamentary stages we identified ways to reduce the visual impact of the scheme, we responded to concerns and the design was changed to a cutting. This means the HS2 line will now run under the A38 and existing railway lines, so that it is less visible in your line of sight.

When we will be working

We will install **overnight closures along the A38 at Streethay between the junction of Cappers Lane and Burton Road:**

Northbound carriageway overnight closures from Tuesday 4 January at 8:00pm to Thursday 6 January at 5:30am.

Southbound carriageway overnight closure from Thursday 20 January at 8:00pm to Friday 21 January at 5:30am. This work is subject to consents.

During these closures, clear diversions and signage will be displayed along the route for road users. There will be narrow lanes and a speed limit of 40 mph, to ensure the safety of the public and contractors.

The above works are in preparation for the construction of the bridge that will begin early 2022. Future traffic management will be required. Once these dates are confirmed, we will share this information with you.

Duration of works

Two nights of overnight closures along the A38 northbound from Tuesday 4 January.

One overnight closure along the A38 southbound from Thursday 20 January.

What to expect

Narrow lanes and 40 mph speed limit in place.

Some noise and vibration generated from the work we are completing.

What we will do

Ensure clear diversion signage is in place for drivers.

Provide free vehicle recovery along the planned diversion routes.

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

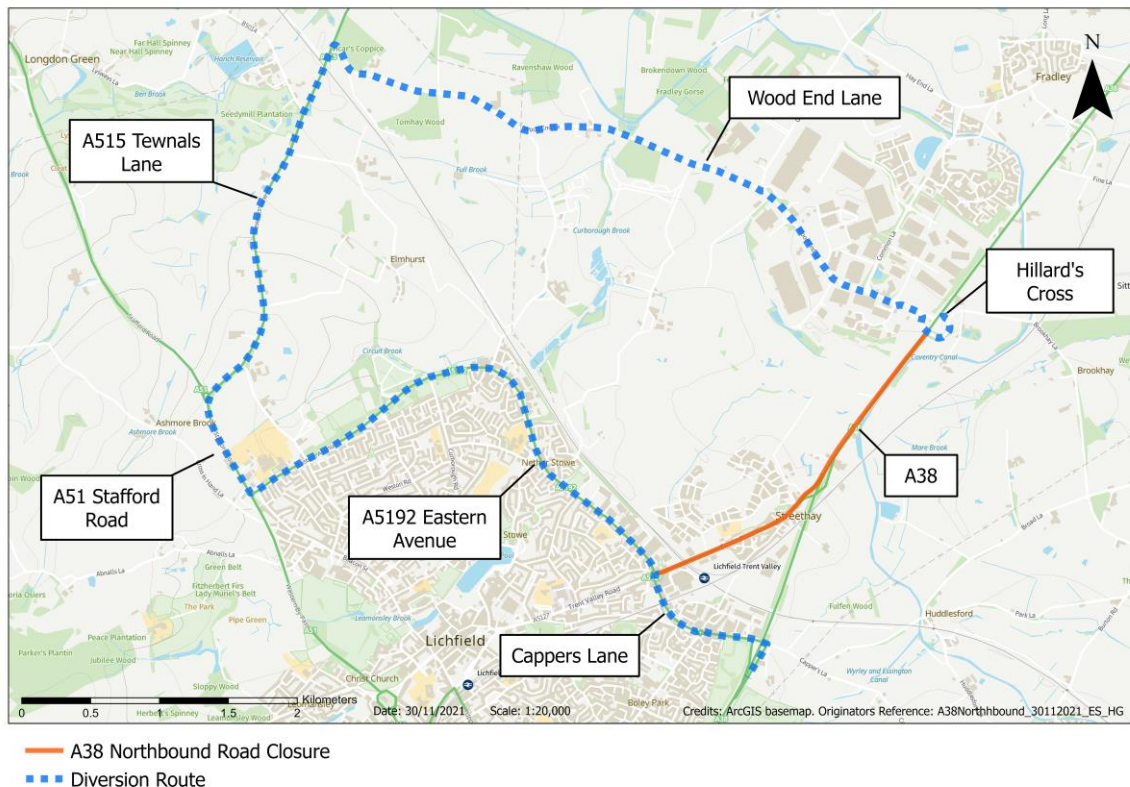

The map below details the A38 overnight closure and diversion route that will be in place from Tuesday 4 January to Thursday 6 January 2022.

Northbound diversion: traffic will be diverted off at Cappers Lane, along A5192 Eastern Avenue, A51, A515, along Wood End Lane and back onto the A38 at Hilliard's Cross.

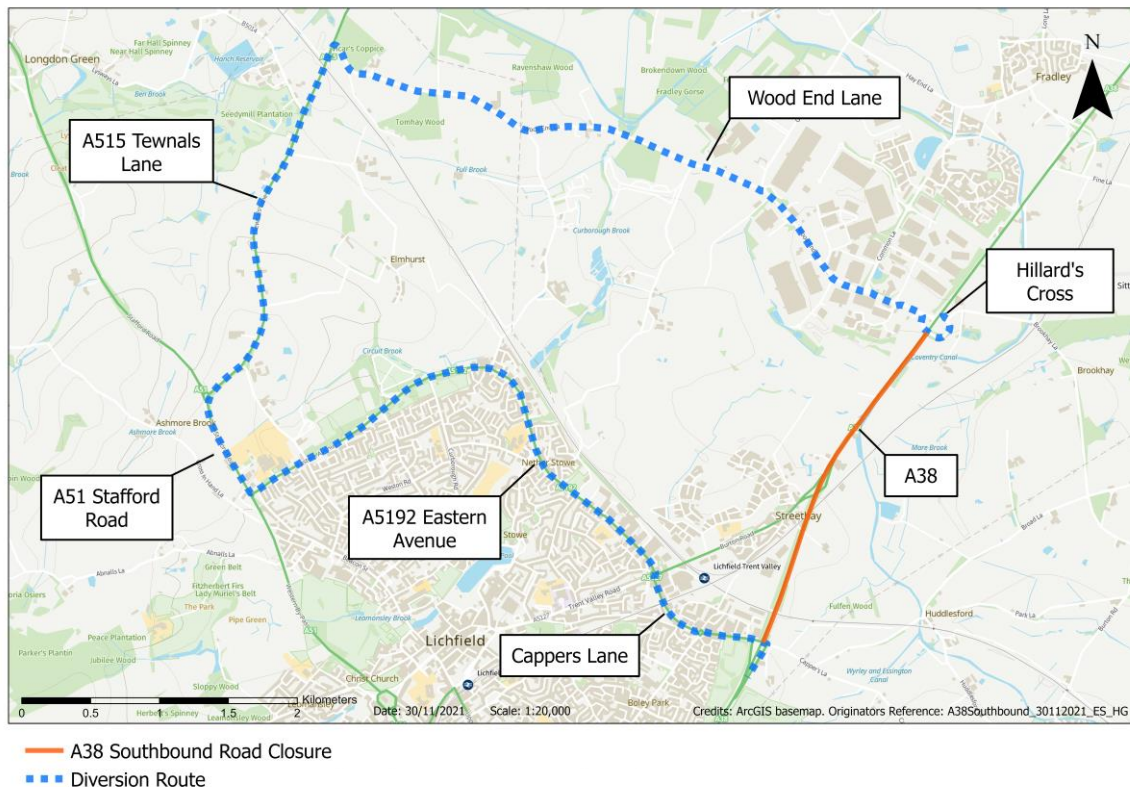

The map below details the A38 overnight closure and diversion route that will be in place from Thursday 20 January to Friday 21 January 2022.

Southbound diversion: traffic will be diverted from Hilliard's Cross, along Wood End Lane, A515, A51, A5192 Eastern Avenue and onto Cappers Lane.
