Design for Parkway utility works due spring 2022

Parkway utility works have been re-programmed:

- Parkway utility works now planned to begin late spring / summer 2022, with tunnelling works now due to start late 2022 or early 2023
- We continue to carry out surveys and investigations to determine the scope of mitigation works required
- We continue to look at options to reduce the impact of these works as we work our way through the planning process
- We will continue to provide updates on the works with further details available in early 2022

Community engagement – November to December 2021

We will engage with those properties closest to the works to understand their access requirements, so we can take this into consideration as we plan the traffic management for the works

Wayfinding handovers

The process for handover between contractors particularly for wayfinding and checking it remains correct and in place.

- Traffic management signs dictated by regulations.
- "Businesses open as usual" signs for road works will now be added to Traffic Management signs to provide consistency.
- Green "A" board signs still in use reviewing numbers and use with a view to ordering more (we will also use them in other areas).

Euston Circus

- HS2 has confirmed that TfL has jurisdiction over the management of this junction. No discussions have taken place between HS2 and TfL in relation to the junction to date.
- TfL has been asked if it has plans to or is considering making improvements to the junction. An update will be provided at the ECRG meeting if available.

Green Spaces

Ross Pearson

Summary of issue

At the agenda setting meeting (11 November 2021) HS2 was asked to set out how it would restore and replace public open space in Camden that had been removed for the construction of the new railway and station.

There was concern expressed that HS2 was waiting or deferring it's responsibility to Lendlease who are the 'Master Development Partner' responsible for the redevelopment around the new Euston Station.

HS2 has two key responsibilities with regards to this issue:

- 1. Improvements to existing open spaces to take account of the loss of open space during construction; and
- 2. Site restoration after the construction of the new station to provide permanent replacement open space.

There are a number of U&As and other obligations on HS2 with regards to open space, but U&A 1137 is key: "The Promoter will require the Nominated Undertaker to actively engage with the London Borough of Camden to ensure the provision of high quality permanent replacement open space and play space within the design for the authorised works in the London Borough of Camden in so far as is reasonably practicable within the limits of the Bill and without impacting the timely and economic delivery of the railway."

Improvement to open spaces during construction

Due to the time before HS2 permanent replacement open space, HS2 is providing approx £7,100,000 of funding to Camden Council over the next ten years for improving existing open spaces and providing new ones.

New or enhanced facilities provided by this funding would remain in place for the community after the completion of HS2.

Permanent open spaces process

HS2 will submit Schedule 17 applications for site restoration, which will set out the details of the proposed permanent replacement open space provision. The details of these plans will be developed alongside the work on the station design and a high level application for site restoration will be submitted alongside the application for the station design. Applications for the detailed design of the site restoration scheme would then follow.

We will engage with the community on site restoration proposals before they're submitted to Camden.

There are four key areas that will make up the HS2 replacement open space:

- Euston Square Gardens;
- Western Gardens immediate west of the new station, north of the former Maria Fidelis school site);
- North (south and east of Hampstead Road, north of the new station); and
- Open space to the north of Langdale (and west of Hampstead Road).

Lendlease will apply directly to Camden Council for their plans and their proposals would have to take account of any consented HS2 replacement open space.

HS2 minister's six monthly report

The HS2 minister reports to Parliament every six months. In the most recent report, it was confirmed that HS2 Euston would be moving from 11 to ten platforms and be built in a single stage instead of two stages.

HS2 Euston station - ten platforms & single stage build

- HS2 has continued design work based on a ten platform station.
- Building the HS2 Euston station in a single stage means that construction will be quicker and will reduce the impact on local communities.
- It will also enable the benefits HS2 will bring to the area to be released quicker. Operational challenges of running half a station while construction continues are also removed.

Engagement on the station design will be carried out in 2022.


