Notice of temporary road closure, Kineton Road, Southam

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. As we increase face to face engagement, in addition to virtual engagement, we will ensure all events and meetings adhere to the guidelines. What are we doing?

In order to avoid using local roads, during the main construction works, we will be using the internal haul and access roads for our construction traffic, reducing the amount of construction traffic on the local highways.

In order to achieve this, we will have temporary traffic management, in the form of two-way traffic lights, on the Kineton Road for approximately two weeks in early-January. This will be followed by the full closure of a small section of the Kineton road, 24 hours a day, for approximately two weeks in mid-January.

During this road closure, we will be creating a strengthened surface using concrete to ensure that we protect the road and any utilities underneath it for the duration of our works.

As the preparatory works will require large plant and machinery, and time for concrete to set, we are required to fully close these sections of road, 24 hours per day. This is for the safety of road users and our staff, who will be working directly in the centre of the highway.

As the project progresses, it is also necessary to remove vegetation to enable future works to continue and to allow access to areas of the site.

When will these works take place?

Kineton Road will have temporary traffic management from Wednesday 5 January to Sunday 16 January.

Kineton Road will be fully closed, 24 hours a day, from Wednesday 19 January to Monday 31 January, with a diversion in place. We will work to open the roads to reduce disruption as soon as possible.

Duration of works

Works will commence Wednesday 5 January 2022

Normal working hours:

Monday to Friday

8.00am – 6.00pm

Weekend working may be required.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

24-hour road closure to allow concrete to set.

Traffic management and some additional traffic.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the works.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

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
