High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. As we increase face to face engagement, in addition to virtual engagement, we will ensure all events and meetings adhere to the guidelines. What are we doing?

Further to our last community notification in December 2021 we are writing to give you an update on the utility diversion works at Calvert Road and Brackley Lane, Calvert.

As we previously explained we will need to undertake further trenching and connection works in Calvert Road and Brackley Lane which will require traffic management.

Brackley Lane - 24/7 3-way temporary traffic lights

The road composite along Brackley Lane is made up of reinforced concrete which has made our works challenging and has extended the time needed to undertake the trenching works. We have also uncovered unchartered services, which has meant we have had to revisit the design to reconfigure and realigning the services along Brackley Lane.

Due to these delays, it has meant that we will have now had to extend the temporary traffic lights on Brackley Lane by one week until the 25 February 2022.

24/7 traffic lights on Brackley Lane from 4 January 2022 until 25 February 2022

Restricted residential parking

Overnight road closure of Calvert Road from 17 January 2022 until 14 February 2022 8pm to 5am

Daytime traffic lights on Calvert Road from 17 January 2022 until 14 February 2022

Work hard to ensure any impacts to residents are kept to a minimum during these works.

What are we doing continued?

Calvert Road - Overnight Road closure 8pm - 5am

Due to uncovering unchartered services along Calvert Road, we have had to revisit the design to reconfigure and realign the services.

Due to these delays, it has meant that we will have had to extend the overnight road closure and daytime traffic lights by one week until the **14 February 2022.**

Through access to emergency services will be permitted during this road closure. The diversion route will be a repeat of the earlier closure route. (please see map enclosed)

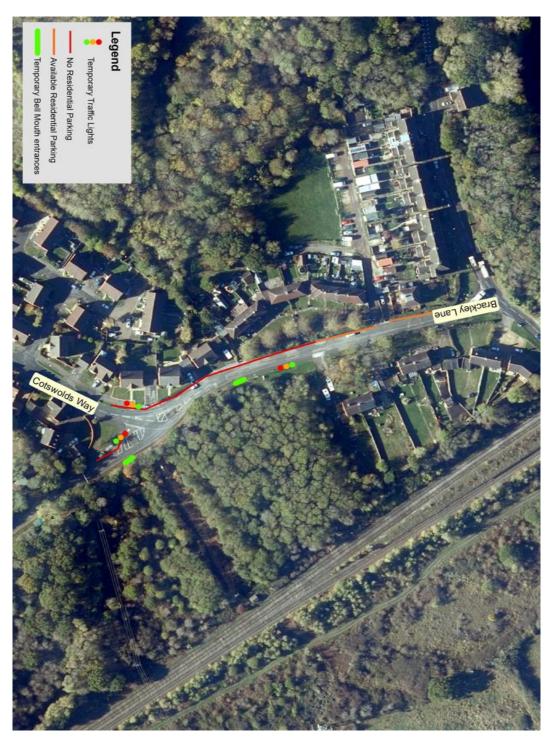

Parking restrictions in place along Brackley Lane 3-way lights - until 25 February 2022

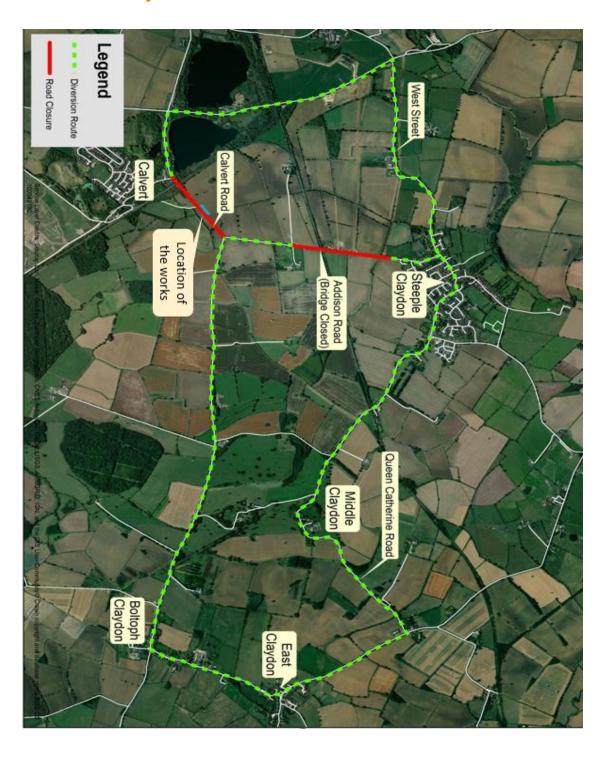
