Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Adelaide Road site	December 2021 to February 2022	 Works are ongoing to set up the Adelaide Road site for future construction of the ventilation shaft and headhouse. Works during this period will include: Piling works to provide ground stability and support during future works to build the ventilation shaft; Installation of access gates; Installation of working platforms for future works; On-site utility connections; Utility protection works within site boundary; Works to protect Network Rail retaining wall; and

Ongoing ground investigations and utility surveys.

Some extended working hours will be required during our ongoing works at the Adelaide Road site. We will provide information to our neighbours in advance of any extended working hours. The latest updates about our ongoing works are available at www.HS2.org.uk/in-your-area/map

Spring 2022 to spring 2023


Works during this period will include:

- Installation of ground anchors;
- Piling works to provide ground stability and support during future works to build the ventilation shaft;
- Excavation and installation of working platforms for future works to build the ventilation shaft and headhouse;
- Installation of site access road and ramp;
- On-site utility connections;
- Utility protection works within site boundary*;
 and
- Piling works for the future headhouse.

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Vehicle Holding Area and Parkway	August 2021 onwards	The Vehicle Holding Area will be in operation until 2033.
Location 1a Park Village East north	February to April 2022	New water connection to SCS work site on Park Village East north (Thames Water) The works will take up to five weeks and will be coordinated with SCS utility works in this section of the road.
Location 2 Camden Cutting	Ongoing until summer 2022	Piling work in the Camden Cutting Piling between Mornington Street and Granby Terrace bridges. More information about our piling methodologies can be found in our factsheet on the www.HS2inCamden.co.uk website.
	Ongoing	Ground anchor installation Ground anchors are being installed from track-side, along the length of the Network Rail retaining wall. These ground anchors are not expected to have any impact on local properties.
	Ongoing until April 2022	Track-level weekend works Track-level surveys, monitoring, site-preparation, and bridge strengthening works during weekend overnight hours. For safety reasons, due to the proximity of the worksites to the tracks, these works can only be carried out overnight during the weekend when trains do not operate.
	January to April 2022	Utility connections to worksite

		Sewer connection followed by the potable water connection works to our worksite at the northern end of Park Village East.
		Works will be carried out within the footway and carriageway, requiring road closures and temporary traffic management. Resident access will be maintained.

Euston Throat	spring 2022	Works to divert the utilities on Hampstead Road from the footway to the north-bound carriageway, to clear working areas
		These works require lane and footway closures, and temporary traffic management on Hampstead Road

	2021 to February 2022	Installation of second site access on Hampstead Road. We will use site access 2 from December to February, while we carry out works to site access 1. We will then revert to site access 1 from February 2022.
		Lane closure and traffic management will be in place on Hampstead Road while site access 2 is installed
	November to December 2021	Harrington Street pedestrian site access
		New pedestrian site access installed at northern end of Harrington Street, behind Langdale.
		Road and footway closure on Harrington Street while pedestrian access is installed
	Ongoing until	Piling work in the Euston Throat
	summer 2024	Piling between Granby Terrace and Hampstead Road.

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Old Maria Fidelis School Site	Late November to late January 2022	Piling works as part of the enabling works for the Construction Skills Centre and welfare site at the former Maria Fidelis School site. This will include creating foundations in the playground area using a piling rig with a rotary bore.
	March 2022	New water connection by Thames Water to the Construction Skills Centre and welfare site compound at the former Maria Fidelis School site. Partial footway closure in pedestrianised passage

		between Hampstead Road and North Gower Street.
Location 2 HS2 Euston Station Site	Ongoing until early December 2021	 Pile trimming and upper wall construction: Enabling works and site preparation; Pile trimming; Installing wall panels and beams; Concreting up the wall; and Backfilling with soft concrete / granular material behind the upper wall.
Location 3 One Euston Square and Grant Thornton Buildings	Ongoing until Summer 2022	 Completion of the demolition of One Euston Square and Grant Thornton buildings' ground floor and basement levels, and associated works. Alteration of current hoarding, including closure of the west colonnade at Euston Station; New hoarding erected within the bus station; Ramp to be constructed to provide a step free fire escape route from the offices and shops on the west colonnade; and Demolition works using combination of pneumatic breaker and claw on columns, walls, ground floor and basement slab.
Location 4 Euston Square Eastern Gardens	Ongoing throughout 2022	Construction of a new interim taxi set-down, pick-up and rank facility to serve Euston Station while the HS2 station is constructed: • Enabling works, including hoarding; • Installation of temporary utilities; • Tree protection; • Site clearance and preparation; • Traffic and pedestrian management; and • Construction of entrance and exits.
Location 5 Former National	Early December 2021 to late February 2022	Enabling works at the former National Temperance Hospital site and the interface with Hampstead Road. Works will include:

Temperance Hospital (Hampstead Road)		 Extension of the hoarding and traffic management along Hampstead Road to enable work in the basement; Pile extraction and installation of piling mat; Removal of redundant petrol station tanks; and UKPN utilities diversion.
Location 6 Euston Square Western Gardens	Ongoing until late 2024	 Relocate the existing Transport for London traction sub-station and vent shaft to enable the HS2 main station construction. Hoardings installation and replacement; Rotary bored piling (daytime) at the location of the new substation building; Sheet piling and removal of pilling equipment; and Excavation (due to start in January 2022).
Location 7a Gower Place	September to November 2021	 Highway UKPN utility works and site compound; and Excavation of a section of the road to connect up new UKPN electricity cables, then reinstatement of the road.
Location 7b North Gower St, between Stephenson Way and Euston Road	September to November 2021 January to March 2022	 Excavation of a section of the road to connect up new UKPN electricity cables, then reinstatement of the road. Demolition and rebuild of an Openreach manhole: Closure of left turn into North Gower Street and traffic diversion in place; Site set-up including hoarding and acoustic screens; Demolition of manhole using pneumatic breaker; and Deep excavation work.
Location 7c	October to December 2021	Excavation of a section of the road to connect up new UKPN electricity cables, then reinstatement of the road.

Location 7d Drummond Street	November 2021 to March 2022	Excavation of a section of the road to connect up new UKPN electricity cables, then reinstatement of the road.
Location 7e Coburg St /	March 2022	New Thames Water connection to southern end of new station footprint for construction activities.
Starcross St		Road closure at corner of Cobourg Street and Starcross Street (offset from pub to minimise disruption).
Various locations west of the station	Ongoing until mid-2022	Replacement and relocation of existing hoardings and installation of new graphics at a number of locations west of the station, including Melton Street, Cobourg Street (south), Regnart Buildings, Stephenson Way and Hampstead Road.
Various locations	Ongoing to December 2021	To understand more about the current sewer system, we are undertaking a number of surveys at various locations.
		Surveys in Stephenson Way, Euston Road, Melton Street and Euston Square will be undertaken at night when pedestrian flow is less, and worksites will be reinstated daily allowing the public access. In all cases the roads will remain open for vehicle access, pedestrian access and access to businesses will be maintained.

Respecting People, Respecting Places

Having listened to feedback from communities and stakeholders, we have refreshed our Community Engagement Strategy. <u>'Respecting People, Respecting Places'</u> highlights how we will always try to do the right thing and reduce disruption to the lives of local people as much as we can during the planning and building of the railway.

Informing

- We will tell you about HS2 works in your area.
- We have local community websites and newsletters with regular information and updates about our work in your area.
- We have local community teams who know your area. They will hold local events and run projects to keep you informed.

Involving

- We will involve you in opportunities to benefit and learn as we build HS2 including jobs, skills, education, employment and funding.
- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

Consulting

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only
 formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall
 outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.

Keeping you informed

We are committed to keeping you informed about work on HS2. This includes ensuring you know what to expect and when to expect it, as well as how we can help.
