High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be constructing a new roundabout, on the A4097 Kingsbury Road, to provide a safe access and egress to the Kingsbury Main Compound. While we construct the new roundabout, we will also complete works to protect a fuel pipe at this location. To complete these works safely we will install a lane closure with temporary traffic lights on the A4097 Kingsbury Road.

When these works will take place

These works will take place from Sunday 20 February until late 2022. To enable us to install the safety barriers and traffic management for the lane closure, we will have an overnight closure of the A4097 Kingsbury Road on Sunday 20 February and Monday 21 February between 7pm – 6am. Please follow the diversion route that will be in place (see map on page two).

Following this overnight closure, a single lane will be in operation, at this location, until late 2022.

We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause.




Location of A4097 Kingsbury Road overnight closure / diversion route
