High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be carrying out utility, topographical and drainage surveys in Middleton and Bodymoor Heath. To complete the surveys a team of engineers will visit the location and record what is present in the area and also carry out trial trenching, which will involve digging into the ground to establish what is underneath the surface. This will provide us with information on the location of drainage and underground utilities, which we need to assess as we develop our construction plans.

When these works will take place

These works will take place between 1 February and 18 February from 9.30 am to 3.30 pm. To complete these works safely we will install closures to the following roads:

Park Lane / Crowberry Lane – 1st February (one day closure)

Church Lane – 7th – 10th February (Three-day closure)

Brick Kiln Lane – 11th February (one day closure)

Cuttle Mill Lane – 14th February (one day closure)

We will have a signed diversion routes in place and access will be maintained to properties and businesses.

Our working hours will be 9.30 am to 3.30 pm (Mon-Fri).

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and after to set up and take down our work equipment.

Closures of local roads while we complete these works.

We will install signage on the roadside.

Some low level noise will be generated from the work we are completing.

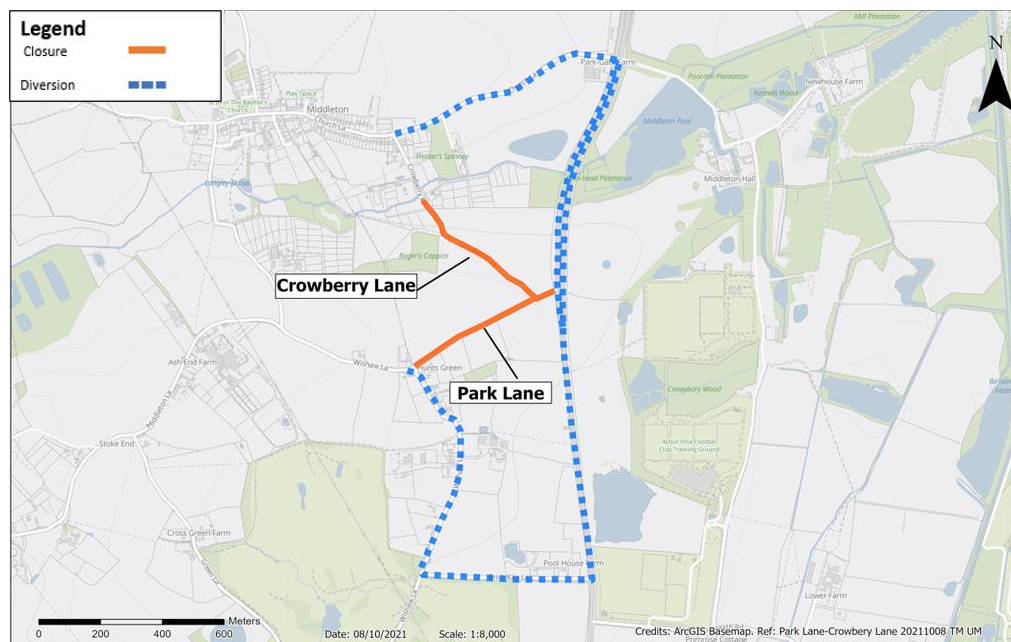

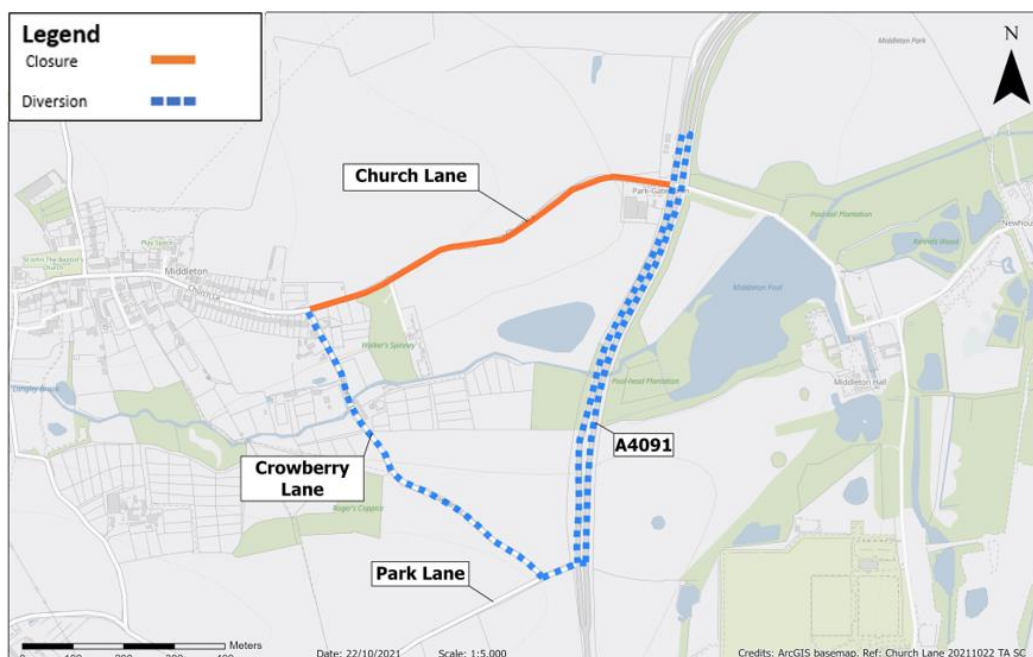
Location of traffic management

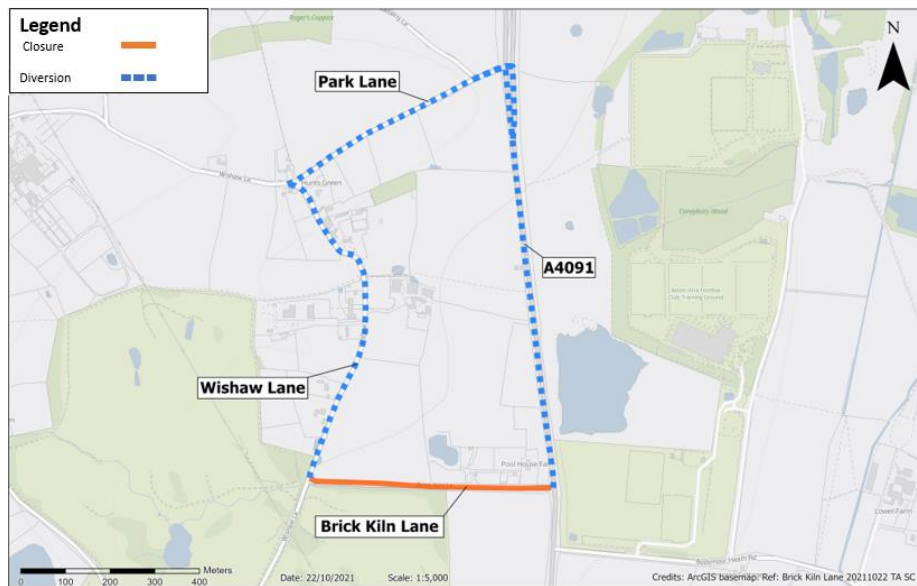
